**SUMMARY:**

On Monday, April 1, 2024, BCI Special Agents Larry Hootman, Chad Doran, and Crime Scene Technician Michael Rostocil assisted the Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Department with the processing of an outdoor crime scene located at multiple locations off E High Avenue in New Philadelphia, OH regarding an officer-involved critical incident. Arrangements were made with BCI Special Agent John Tingley to process the involved vehicles: Ford F150 Raptor (OH-FOG6603) and Tuscarawas County Sheriff Ford Interceptor vehicle # [REDACTED] on Wednesday, April 3, 2024.

**DETAILS:**

On Wednesday, April 3, 2024, at approximately 1000 hours, BCI SA Larry Hootman, Chad Doran and CST Rostocil arrived at 1447 OH-39, New Philadelphia, OH 44663 (Rosenberry Towing) to process the silver 4-door Ford F150 Raptor (OH-FOG 6033) recovered from 145 8<sup>th</sup> Street NE, New Philadelphia, OH 44663 on April 1, 2024. The vehicle was processed under the authority of a search warrant obtained by BCI SA John Tingley.

SA Doran photographed the exterior and interior of the vehicle as it was found outside in the secured fenced area (Figures #1-5). The vehicle exhibited damage to the front end. The vehicle was searched for items of suspected evidence and one (1) item of suspected evidence was located, documented, and collected; identified as a black Apple iPhone located on the front driver seat (Figure #6). It was determined that the phone was originally on the driver floorboard but was placed onto the seat by a tow truck driver.
