I am therefore of the opinion that the fee to be charged for filing the articles of incorporation of the Repair Machinists' Benefit Association of Ohio is governed by Section 176, Subsection 5, providing:

"The Secretary of State shall charge and collect the following fees for official services:

5. For filing and recording all other articles of incorporation of all other corporations having no capital stock, ten dollars."
