Narrative:

On January 23, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Najmulski (SA Najmulski) reviewed background information on involved Moses Alik (Alik) regarding the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) on December 31, 2024. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records (if applicable), and open/closed-source database inquiries. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Celina Police Department (CPD).

SA Najmulski reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Police Encounters:

- 1. 04/07/2024-Arrested by Celina PD for Disorderly Conduct by Fighting
- 2. 12/31/2023-Arrested by Celina PD for Obstructing Official Business
- 3. 04/30/2023 Arrested by Celina PD for Theft, Obstructing Official Business, Resisting Arrest and Offenses involving Underage Persons
- 4. 10/15/2013-Arrested by Celina PD for Persistent Disorderly Conduct Alcohol
- 5. Mercer County Jail records indicate Alik talked to himself in his cell, acted strangely and complained of hearing voices and being scared.

NARRATIVE

At 2329 Inmates Lokot-Bunglick and Alik were caught talking to one another through the 3F door. Dep Oakley made the call to place them in lockdown.

Dep Oakley, Dep Fox, and Dep Etzler entered Dorms 3 and 4 at 2333.

Alik placed in cell 6 at 2335.

Lokot-Bunglick placed in cell 13 at 2338.

SUPPLEMENTAL: Josh Sizemore

Dep Sizemore Report from Control

At 2329, I witnessed Inmates Lokot and Alik approaching the 3F door after Dep Oakley had warned them not to talk to each other through the doors. She advised me to keep watch during my time in control, because this was not the first time in the last week that they had been warned. Once I witnessed them speaking through the door, I radioed to Dep Oakley and advised of the situation.

Dep Oakley, Dep Fox and Dep Etzler all collected outside of the dorms and headed back to transfer those inmates to lockdown at 2333. Dep Fox and Dep Oakley went through Dorm 1 and Dorm 3 on the tops to interact with Inmate Alik. Dep Etzler went through the bottom of Dorm 3 to interact with Inmate Lokot.

At 2335 Inmate Alik was placed in cell 6 and shortly after at 2338, Inmate Lokot was placed in cell 13. No issues occurred during the transfer to Dorm 5.

SUPPLEMENTAL: Will Fox

Dep. Fox's Notes:

On 10/18/23 at 2334 Dep Sizemore advised over the radio that inmate Moses and inmate Lokot were communicating through the door after being warned multiple times to stop or they would be placed in lockdown. The walkthrough prior I warned inmate Lokot that he can not talk through the door when I witnessed him speaking through the door. Dep Etzler Dep Oakley and myself entered the dorms with Dep Etzler entering Dorm 3 to take Lokot to lockdown and Dep Oakley and I entering Dorm 4 to take inmate Moses to lock down. When Dep Oakley and I entered Dorm 4, Dep Oakley informed inmate Moses that he was going to be placed in lockdown for talking through the door. Inmate Moses stated he was

telling Inmate Lokot that they can not talk anymore because he did not want to be placed in lockdown. Dep Oakley informed Moses that Dep Sizemore witnessed inmate Lokot and inmate Moses at the doors and checked the intercoms to ensure they were talking and he would still be going to lockdown. Inmate Moses gathered his belongings and Dep Oakley and I brought him to the top of Dorm 5. Dep Oakley inspected Moses towel blanket and sheet then took the rest of his belongings down to intake to be inspected.

SUPPLEMENTAL: Chad Etzler

Dep Etzler's Notes

At 23:29, Controlled radioed that inmates Bunglick and Moses were talking through the 3F door. This has been an ongoing with Moses trying to get out of dorm 4 and into 3 with Bunglick. Several times tonight they were warned when I was in conrol and also by Dep Oakley and Dep Fox while completing checks earlier. At this point it was decided that lockdown was warranted as these two inmates were continually disobeying staff and not following instructions. Dep Oakley and Dep Fox went to dorm 4 to retrieve inmate Moses. I went to dorm 3 for Bunglick. I entered dorm 4 and instructed inmate Bunglick to pack up is rack. At first he laughed as he thought I was joking. I told him he was being placed in lockdown for not following instructions and talking through the door. He quickly packed his bag and i escorted him to dorm 5 without issue. Once i left the dorm i heard a loud bang and talking. I reentered dorm 5 to find inmate Bunglick standing on his sink in cell13 and talking into the vent to inmate Moses in cell 6. I told Moses he can not be standing on the sink as he could fall and get hurt and not to be talking through the vent. He did climb down and I exited the dorm. Control did advise that those two inmates were being loud in dorm 5 after we left.

SUPPLEMENTAL: Hannah Oakley

Dep. Oakley's Notes:

At 2253, during my walk-through, I was walking through the top of 4 and waiting at the 4F door when inmate Alik when to the 3F door and knocked on it. I advised Alik not to talk through the door or else he would be placed in Lockdown because I had warned him during my previous shift on 10/15/23. I radioed to Dep. Etzler, whom was in Control at the time, to keep an eye on the 3F door and make sure Alik and Lokot-Bunglick are not talking through it. Before I got to the 5F door, Dep. Etzler radioed that they were back at the door. I completed my walk-through and went up to Control to talk with Dep. Etzler and to see if they we're still talking. Dep. Fox met me in Control where he advised that he had also warned inmate Bunglick not to talk through the door. When I arrived in the Control, I witnessed inmate Bunglick knock on the door and inmate Alik move towards the door, but not close enough to where they could be talking. I stayed up there for about 5 minutes and they did not approach the door. I asked Dep. Sizemore, whom was now in Control at the time, to let me know if they talked through the door again. I advised him that if they were caught again that they would be placed in Lockdown due violating 2 Minor Violations: "#6 Making contact and / or passing items to someone not in your dorm" as well as "#11 Failure to obey correctional staff". At 2329hrs, Dep. Sizemore, radioed that Bunglick and Alik were at the door speaking again. I hit the intercom at Control and asked Dep. Sizemore to hit the intercom to verify they were speaking. Dep. Sizemore advised he already had and verified that they were talking to each other. Dep. Fox and I went up through Dorm 1 and across the top to enter the top of Dorm 4 where Inmate Alik was. Dep. Etzler went into Dorm 3, Downstairs, to assist Bunglick to Lockdown. When I arrived to Dorm 4, I advised Alik to pack up his things that he was going to be placed in Lockdown. Alik asked me why to which I advised him that I asked him multiple times to not talk through the door to other inmates and reminded him that this was not the first time I had caught him and advised him to not. Alik advised he understood, complied and walked through the 5F door into Cell 6. No other issues were caused throughout the night.

While in control I received a call from Ptl Nelson from CPD advising that the male Isaac Kern that they had brought in was not Isaac Kern that he was using a fake name but they did not know who he was. When I came out of control I pulled him out of the cell and asked him what his name was. He advised me Isaac Kern. I told him I knew his name was not that and that if he did not tell us his correct information that he would not be getting out of jail until we could confirm who he was which would take awhile. He then advised me his name was Moses Alik and gave me his date of birth. I received more information about his previous address's and states he had lived in and relayed the information back to Ptl Nelson. I also had Dispatch try and run him through either Hawaii or Washington as he had advised he had lived in both of those places. A previous address had popped up from Hawaii so I asked him what his address was when he lived in Hawaii and he advised me that his address was the same address that I had listed on the printout. I relayed this to CPD and changed all of his information in Spillman and Lockdown and on all of his paperwork.

Celina squad arrived on scene prior to officers and advised the defendant was found on the middle of the street passed out and was woke up by squad members.

At 0417 hrs on the same date Celina officers warned the defendant for Disorderly as he was asleep on the sidewalk at Boots and Bourbon Bar.

The defendant was found to still be intoxicated he as smelled strongly of an alcoholic beverage, his speech was slurred and his eyes were bloodshot and watery. The defendant also admitted to being intoxicated.

He was placed under arrest for Persistent Disorderly Conduct and transported to MCSO jail.

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Stated date and time officers were dispatched to the 200-block of W. Warren St in reference to a male passed out, unresponsive in the roadway. Celina squad was also dispatched to scene.

Shortly I after I arrived on scene. Celina squad were on scene and had the male awake sitting in the squad.

I knew the male to be Moses Alik, who at 0415 hrs on the same date I previously warned for disorderly conduct as he was passed out on the sidewalk in front of Boots and Bourbon Bar. During that call I woke up Moses and he was able to walk under his own power, but was obviously intoxicated.

Squad members advised that Moses was not in need of medical attention.

While speaking with Moses I again detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. His speech was also slurred and his eyes were blood shot and watery. It was apparent Mose's was still very intoxicated.

At this time Moses was placed under arrest for persistent disorderly conduct.

He was then transported to MCSO jail where he was booked in for the same.

On 04/30/2023 at 0854 hours Celina officers were dispatched to S_{\star} Main St. Marathon in reference to a theft that had occurred.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke with a cashier who advsied two males had stolen two bottles of liquor around 0845 hours. Security footage displayed both suspects grab one bottle of liquor each and place the bottles inside their coats/sweat shirts.

The suspects then left the store without making an attempt to pay for the items.

Officers then located one of the suspects, who was matching the description from the video, sitting on the front porch of 316 S. Walnut St.

Officers then spoke with the suspect and he then took off running south on S. Walnut St. Officers chased after the male and advised him to stop and he was under arrest. The male continued running.

Officers then caught the male in the 200 block of W. Fayette St. Officers ordered the suspect to get on the ground and he continued to refuse. Officers then had to tackle the suspect to the ground.

The male then provided a name of "Isaac Kerns" and did not have any form of identification on him. "Kerns" advsied that he was 20 years old and had an odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. "Kerns" advsied he was afraid of being arrested for stealing so that is why he ran.

"Kerns" continued to state that this was his name "Isaac Kerns"

"Kerns" was later transported to the jail where he was incarcerated for Theft, Under age Alcohol Consumption, Obstructing Official Business, and Resisting Arrest.

Resisting Arrest elevated to M1 due to injuries of arresting officers.

Jail staff later advsied that "Kerns" provided them with an additional name of "Moses Alik" this second name is still unconfirmed.

On 04/30/2023 at 0854 hours I was dispatched to S. Main St. Marathon in reference to a theft that had occurred around 0845 hours. I arrived on scene and came into contact with the cashier who stated that two bottles of liquor had been stolen.

The cashier then played video footage of two Marshalees males entering the store, both later identified as Moses Alik and Betwell Bellu Jr. (17yrs)

Alik is observed going up to the liquor counter located near the front register and grabbing a bottle of Malibu Strawberry Liquor. Alik then walks away from the counter and hides the bottle under his coat. Bellu Jr. then walks up after Alik and grabbed a bottle of RumChata liquor.

Bellu Jr. then took the bottle of RumChata and walked to the coolers located on the south end of the store. Bellu Jr. is then observed placing the bottle in his clothing to conceal the bottle. Both Alik and Bellu Jr. then walk out of the store without making an attempt to pay for the bottles.

I then had the cashier send a copy of the video to my email. The cashier stated that both bottles were priced at \$25.00 each.

I then left the store and patrolled the area looking for both males. I then observed Alik sitting on the front steps of a house at 316 S. Walnut St. I then exited my cruiser and asked Alik where the stolen bottle of liquor was. Alik initially denied stealing any bottles. I then showed Alik a photo of him in the store and he responded "is that me?" I responded yes and Alik immediately took off running south on S. Walnut towards Logan St.

Alik then started running east on Logan St. and again ran north through back yards. I continually yelled at Alik to stop and that he was under arrest and he refused to comply. Alik then started to run north east across S. Walnut St. and I entered my cruiser to follow him.

Alik was then again located trying to hide behind a dumpster in the Kerns Chevrolet car lot. Alik then ran from behind the dumpster to the north in the alley way to W. Fayette St.

As I turned onto W. Fayette St. I ordered Alik again to stop running and to get on the ground. Alik turned around to face me and yelled "why?" I was then able to exit my cruiser and tackle Alik to the ground. While on the ground I was then able to handcuff Alik. During the tackle, I sustained minor injuries to both elbows and my right wrist.

Alik was then placed in the back of my cruiser and read his Miranda Rights. Alik stated that he was just nervous about being arrested and he just ran. Alik admitted that he had stole the bottle. I was able to detect a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath as well.

I then asked Alik for identification and he stated that he did not have any drivers license on him. Alik then stated to me that his name was "Isaac Kern" Alik continued to provide this name while being questioned. Alik then provided a birth date of 03/08/2003 and stated "he was 20." I also questioned Alik about who Bellu Jr. was due to not having that information at the time of Alik's arrest. Alik did not want to provide a name for Bellu Jr. and only stated a name of "Jun Jun"

Alik was then transported to the Mercer County Jail where he was incarcerated for Theft, Under age Alcohol Consumption, Obstructing Official Business, and Resisting Arrest.

Alik later advsied jail staff that his name was Moses Alik and proper identification was located for Alik after he provided a false name.

On 04/30/2023 at 2109 hours 2nd shift officers were dispatched to the area of Peoples Bank on W. Logan St. in reference to Bellu Jr. wanting to turn himself in. Ptl. Nelson then spoke with Bellu who admitted to stealing the bottle of RumChata. Bellu Jr. had drank the bottle and fell asleep. Bellu Jr. stated that he was unable to find Alik on the jail web site and when asked about the name "Isaac Kern" Bellu stated he did not know anyone by the name of Isaac. Bellu then refused to

NOTICE OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH COMMUNITY CONTROL SANCTIONS

Now comes Sammi Timmerman, Celina Municipal Court Probation Officer, and respectfully request the court to bring the defendant herein before this Court to answer to the charge(s) that he has violated his community control issued on May 11, 2023.

COUNT 1 – On November 12, 2024 I received a report from Celina Police Department stating that on November 9, 2024 they were dispatched to the laundry at 1400 W Market St on a report of a male sleeping inside. Upon arrival officers located the male and identified him at Moses Alik. Two tall boy cans of Milwaukee's Best Ice beer were observed on the shelf, and the defendant confirmed those belonged to him. Moses also stated that he drank 2-3 cans of beer. Also, the contact the defendant had with the Celina Police Department this night was never reported to me by him as ordered.

COUNT 2- On November 18, 2024 I tried to call the defendant at the number he has on file however the number is no longer in service. I then mailed the defendant a notice of appointment to the address he has on file, to appear in this court on November 27, 2024 at 1:00 pm so that we could address the report I received from the Celina Police Department. The defendant failed to appear for the scheduled appointment and I have not heard from him.

Therefore, the defendant has violated the following terms of his community control:

- Condition 2: Any contact with Law Enforcement must be reported to the Probation Department within 12 hours.
- Condition 3: You must keep your Probation Officer informed of your current address, telephone number, and employment status at all times. A change of address, employment, or telephone number must be reported within 24 hours to your Probation Officer.
- Condition Number 4: You must maintain contact with your Probation Officer on a regular basis. You
 must attend all scheduled appointments set for you. If you fail to attend an appointment without 24
 hours' notice given, a probation violation may be filed.
- Condition Number 6 and 7: You are not to possess or consume any alcohol/or drugs of abuse. You
 are required to submit to random urine screens and/or alcohol testing if requested by any law
 enforcement officer, health agency, or probation officer. Refusal of any test is an automatic violation
 of your probation. If any drug of abuse or alcohol is detected in your system, or any form of drug
 paraphernalia is found on your person, your probation is subject to revocation.

On 12-31-2023 at approx. 0320 hrs, officers were dispatched to the area of E. Market St. @ S. Lake St. on a report of an active fight between 4-5 subjects.

Upon arriving, multiple subjects were located in the parking lot of the Super Wash on E. Market St. @ S. Lake St.

During the course of the investigation, one of the subjects, identified as Moses Alik (dob 03-08-2002), was released from the scene by officers. Mr. Alik returned and began video recording officer's continued interactions with another involved party who could not be positively identified. Mr. Alik was advised that he could record but he was advised to stay back and not to interfere with officer's continued interactions with the subject. Mr. Alik repeatedly re-approached the officers and subject and was repeatedly warned to stay back. On several occasions, Mr. Alik told the subject that he should not speak to or identify himself to officers. He also repeatedly interrupted officers, demanding names and badge numbers.

After multiple interruptions by Mr. Alik, he was placed under arrest for Obstructing Official Business, ORC 2921.31 (M2) and incarcerated in the Mercer Co. Jail.

On 12-31-2023 at approx. 0320 hrs, Off. Powell, Off. Balthis, and I were dispatched to the area of E. Market St. @ S. Lake St. on a report of an active fight. The caller advised that 4-5 individuals were around a red vehicle fighting.

Upon arriving, we observed a red 2007 Ford 4D, OH HQK5541, parked on the east end of the business lot of the Super Wash. There were several subjects standing around outside of the vehicle.

We made contact with the subjects, who claimed that they were having car problems and denied that there was any fight. Two of the subjects, Moses Alik (dob 03-08-2002) and Nena Nashon (dob 01-29-1998), were identified and advised that they could leave. Mr. Nashon made the comment that "they will know where I live," indicating to two other subjects on the scene, before he and Mr. Alik walked away.

Off. Powell attempted to identify the other two parties, later identified at Brittany L. Ward (dob 04-25-1990) and Jarvis D. Dillingham (dob 01-13-1987). Mr. Dillingham had identified himself as "Michael Smith Jr" to Off. Powell, but no information could be located through LEADS.

While we attempted to identify Mr. Dillingham, Mr. Alik walked back up to the scene, approaching to within a few feet of me and recording the interaction on his cell phone. Mr. Alik was advised that we didn't care that he was recording us but that he needed to stay back and not interfere with our interaction with Mr. Dillingham. Mr. Alik backed a short distance away but then started calling out and gesturing to Mr. Dillingham that he should not talk to us or identify himself. He was advised to stop interfering with us and again told to back away. Mr. Alik repeatedly re-approached us, coming up behind me as we interacted with Mr. Dillingham, and was again backed away and warned for Obstructing Official Business, at which point he demanded our names and badge numbers.

Off. Powell was able to positively identify Mr. Dillingham and was inquiring as to why he was lying to us about his identification when Mr. Alik moved to the sidewalk near the vehicle and again began attempting to involve himself in our interactions with Mr. Dillingham. At that point, I approached Mr. Alik and placed him under arrest for Obstructing Official Business, ORC 2921.31 (M2). He was transported to the Mercer Co. Jail where he was incarcerated. His court date was set for 01-02-2024 at 1330 hrs in Celina Municipal Court.

Mr. Hickerson was cited for DOC, ORC 2917.11A1 (MM), and his court date was set for 04-15-2024 at 1330 hrs in Celina Municipal Court. He was provided with a copy of the citation and released.

On the above date dispatch notified Deputy Wehe and I that there had been a "shots fired" call in Celina and they were requesting our assistance at the Marathon gas station on Main St. Wehe and I responded and when I arrived I parked blocking the front entrance off Main St. on the South side. An ambulance was on the North side of the station and several officers and Deputies were on scene. I was told a male suspect was in the ambulance and had been shot by a Mercer County deputy and that the deputy was un-injured.

After the ambulance left I assisted Celina PD in taping off the scene. Deputy Wehe blocked off the intersection of the allies located behind the station. While there I observed Deputy Wehe speaking to a male that approached her on foot. I joined the two and the male was asking if the person shot was wearing a shiny puffy coat. I told him I did not know because I wasn't here when the incident occurred. He stated he believes it was his cousin and explained how earlier his cousin was acting strange telling him invisible people were chasing him. I told the male he would need to speak to someone investigating the case and asked Poppe of the Celina Police Department to come over. Poppe spoke to the male who then left.

Deputy Wehe and I were relieved of duty by a Mercer County S.O. before responding back to our county.

On the above date, deputies were advised that shots were fired at the Marathon gas station in Celina. Sgt. Chisholm and I left the office in emergency response to provide assistance to the adjacent county. While enroute, we were advised that no updates were available.

Upon my arrival in the area of Market Street and Main Street, I observed flashing lights south where I know the gas station is. I parked along Main Street north of the gas station. I withdrew my agency issued patrol rifle from my assigned cruiser, and I approached the area where other law enforcement officers had gathered.

I learned that the situation was not active. Thus, I returned my assigned rifle to my patrol vehicle. I would ultimately move to the area of the alley just south of the Marathon gas station. I positioned my patrol vehicle in the alley in a direction southwest of the Marathon gas station. The overhead lights remained on. I directed only a few subjects to reroute their direction of travel to avoid the scene.

Around 0543 hrs. (per the time stamp on cruiser camera footage from 6-6), I began walking towards a subject that was out on foot looking towards the scene. As I got closer, I asked the male if I could help him. He asked me who got shot. I said, "um," and paused because I was not privy to disclosing that information, nor did I know the identity and/or identities of anyone, other than law enforcement, involved. The male said, "Moses Alik. Stop lying. Who who got shot." I began to attempt to explain to him that I work for the Auglaize County Sheriff's Office, when he said, "I can tell you where he where he was before here. I can tell you where he was before before he got shot. Just tell me who it was." I told the male I didn't know, and I, again, tried to explain to him that I work for ACSO.

The male asked, "Was he wearing a puffer shinny jacket." For the third time, I told him that I work for an Auglaize County agency. This time, I added that I could find someone who could speak with him. The male said, "... he was just here at my house." He wanted to know the identity of the person involved and mentioned that the subject was his cousin. He said, "I don't care cause he he... raped my cousin. I don't care. But all I want to know is who got shot."

The male, again, asked about a shinny jacket. I assured him that I did not know, and that I was not lying to him.

He continued to converse with me. The male motioned with his hand and finger extended towards an orange sedan that was south of our location. He said, "I know he was out here. He was entering this car." The male said, "...he was like... people are following me invisible people." He indicated that he had thought his cousin was drunk. The male advised me that his cousin didn't have a gun, and he asked, "...so why did y'all shoot him."

I asked the male if he would be okay with me asking someone to come over here to hear his account. He said no several times. Even so, I radioed for my sergeant to come this way. The male indicated that I'd used the "walkie-talkie," and he was aware that my camera was on. I had requested my sergeant, because I didn't feel that I could talk with this male and relay information to other officers on scene simultaneously. As Sgt. Chisholm was approaching, the male indicated that he'd tell us both what happened.

The male did tell us, "Well I can tell you that he... I think he was on drugs..." He, again, mentioned his cousin. He continued, "He don't act like that normally..." He told us that his cousin had claimed to need a belt. The male did say that, "...first he was grabbing my sister-in-law." At this time, Sgt. Chisholm asked the male for his cousin's name. He again mentioned the name Moses Alik.

The male had mentioned that he didn't want this on record. Sgt. Chisholm was trying to coordinate for investigators to speak with this male. Sgt. Chisholm returned with two Celina Police Department officers shortly thereafter, whom I was familiar with and knew them to be Detective Taylor and Detective Poppe. Further conversation took place between the male and CPD detectives. The male was informed by Officer Poppe that he would need to identify himself, and he did write something down on a post-it note I had provided to him. It had been raining, and the ink did become distorted. I have saved the post-it note in a case jacket.

The detectives did inform the male that they might come to talk to him in a little bit. He gave a couple of us fist bumps, and then he walked away.

On stated date and time officers were called to 217 Elm St in reference to a vehicle theft. The vehicle has been returned.

Upon arriving I spoke Derik Jeffries and Chase Kulhman. Derik explained that Chase had asked him if his camera on his front door had captured a hit skip accident that occurred sometimes earlier. Derik advised he had gone through his camera and observed an individual attempting to get into a vehicle across the street and then walk to his truck and get in and proceed to drive away. He then proceeded to show the footage of his camera which is attached to this report. A younger looking male wearing a jacket can be seene coming onto the property carrying what appears to be a liquor bottle possibly. He then gets into the truck parked in the driveway of the residence. The vehicle then leaves the residence. The camera footage picks up the vehicle several times as it drives by. The vehicle can be seen pulling into the driveway to he south and then backing up. The vehicle then parks across the street but then drives off. A Short time later hte vehicle returns to the residence and parks in the driveway. The male then exits the vehicle and walks to the south from the residence. The time on the footage is incorrect. The time from of the incident occured 12/22/2024 at approximately 2326 hours to 12/27/2024 0200

The following day I went to 321 Elm St to see if the camera on the front door observed anything. It did not.

On 12/27/24 I had taken a report of hit skip crash that occurred in front of 218 Elm St. I was later informed by Officer Nelson that he had taken a report of stolen vehicle at 217 Elm St but the vehicle was returned the same night. Officer Nelson was able to obtain footage of the truck being taken and then returned. During the video the truck was observed to back into the vehicle involved in the crash. No damage was reported on the truck.

On 12/31/24 while assisting BCI in an officer involved shooting investigation, I was shown video of Moses Alik stealing alcohol from S Main St Marathon, presumably on 12/27/24 Moses was wearing a reflective/metallic winter jacket and white and grey pants. During the time I had forgotten about the stolen vehicle report. Off Nelson later brought up that the suspect in the vehicle theft appeared to be wearing the same jacket. I advised him I would check back with Marathon and get video from the night.

On 01/02/25 I checked with 303 S Main St. They pulled up video of 12/27/24 at 0130. Moses drives into the parking lot with the Grey Ford Truck. Enters the store wearing the jacket and grey pants. Steals a bottle of Fireball, conceals it and enters the driver seat of the truck. The truck then leaves onto Main St.

The video at marathon confirms that Moses had taken the truck from S Elm St and returned it. He is believed to have stolen it for approx. 3 hours, as the time stamps on the home video is off by 3 hours.
