On Wednesday, April 24, 2024, at approximately 0904 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) and SA Jack Shea (Shea) interviewed Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) who was accompanied by Paul Siegferth (Siegferth), attorney from the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Ohio Labor Council (OLC). Also present was Eric Changet from the FOP/OLC. The interview took place at the TCSO which is located at 2295 Reiser Avenue SE, New Philadelphia, Tuscarawas County, Ohio. The interview was audio recorded.



The interview began with SA Tingley presenting with the BCI Criminal Investigation Notification form which read, understood, and signed.


