DEAR SIR:—You have submitted an abstract, last continued by J. K. Kennedy, attorney, on July 30, 1920, and requested my written opinion in reference to the status of the title to the following described premises:

“Situate in the township of Clinton, county of Franklin and state of Ohio and being lot No. thirty seven (37) of Wood Brown Place as the same is numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat thereof of record in plat book No. 5, pages 196 and 197 recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio.”

A careful examination has been made and it is believed that said abstract discloses a good and sufficient title to said premises to be in the name of Grover C. Seegar on July 30, 1920, the date of the last continuation of said abstract, free from incumbrances excepting the taxes for the year 1920 which are unpaid and a lien.
