If you live in any of these municipalities...

**PREVENT THE SPREAD OF GERMS**

- 1. Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- 2. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- 3. Use tissues when you are sick.
- 4. Cover your cough or sneeze with a cloth. Don't touch the tissue to the front.
- 5. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- 6. Follow CDC's recommendations for staying at home.
- 7. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- 8. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

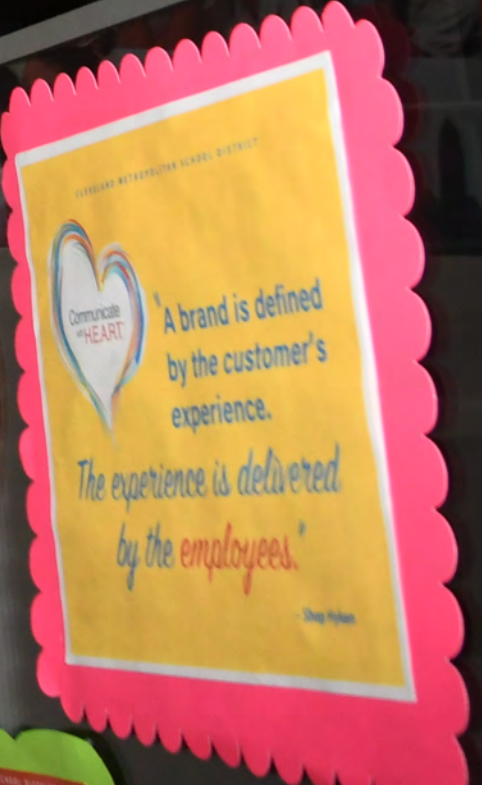
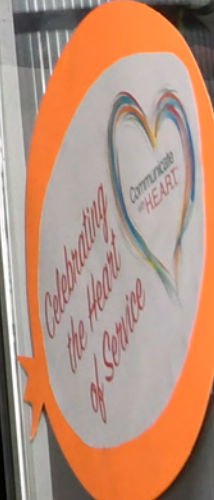
**Eligible students have the right to:**

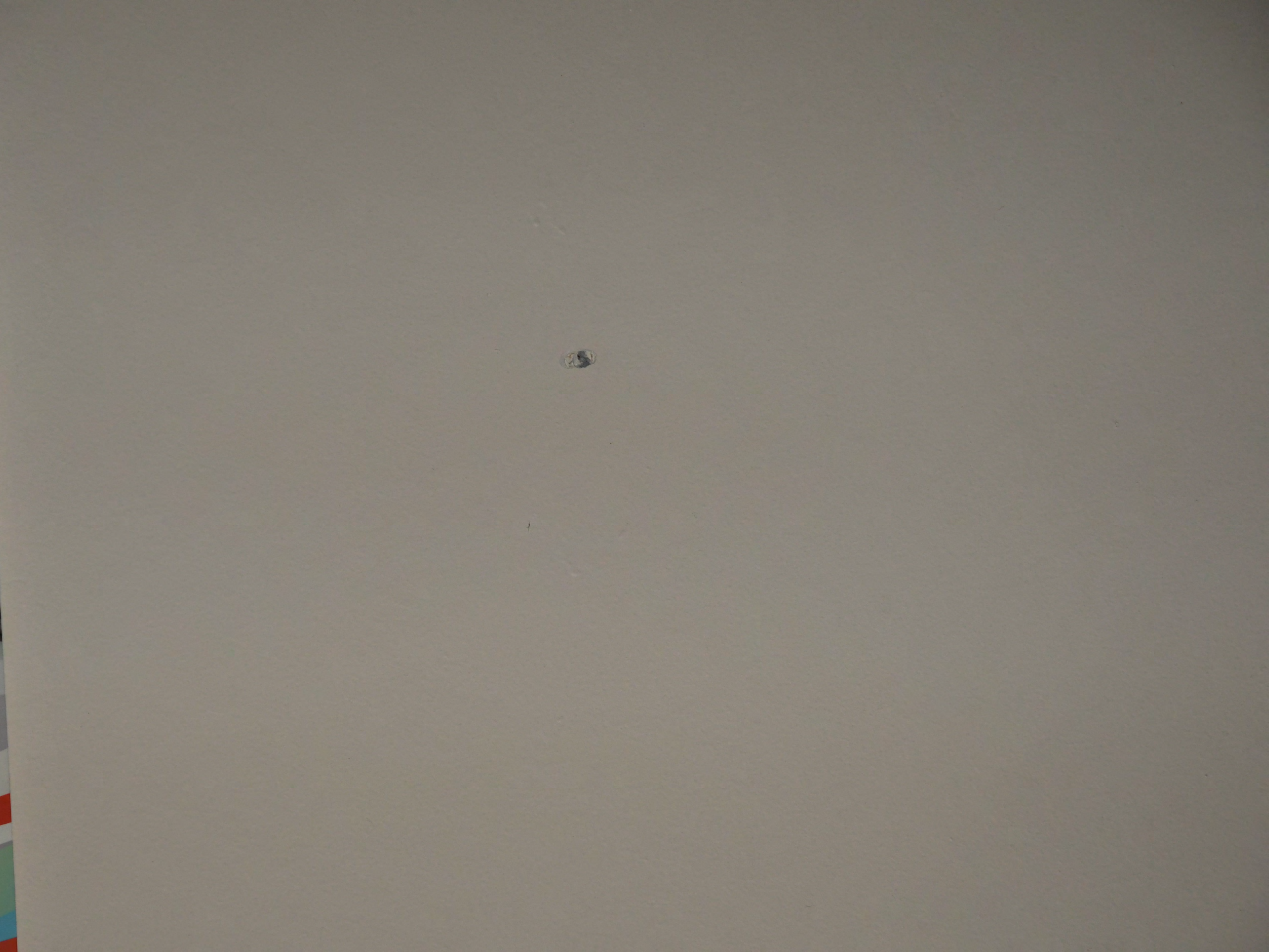
- receive a free, appropriate public education
- receive a school immediately upon enrollment or transfer to another school
- receive a school and attend classes under the district's regular bus routes
- receive a free transportation to and from their school of origin, if requested
- receive educational services comparable to those provided to all students in the district

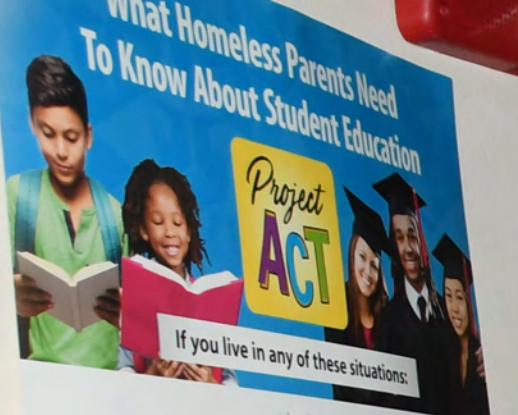

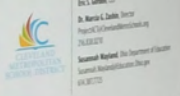

Eligible students have the right to:

- receive a free, appropriate public education.
  - enroll in school immediately, even if you cannot present documents normally required for enrollment.
  - enroll in school and attend classes while the District gathers the required documents.
  - enroll in their neighborhood school or continue to attend their District school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled, if that is their preference and it is feasible).
- If the District believes that the school selected is not in the student's best interest, the District must provide a written explanation of its position and inform the student of his/her right to appeal.
- receive transportation to and from their school of origin, if requested.
  - receive educational services comparable to those provided to all students in the District.
