DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and W. M. Bardo, of 2105 Robinwood Avenue, Toledo, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of Generator and Compressor Room for the Toledo State Hospital and calls for an expenditure of \$2,880.00.
