Narrative:

On October 28, 2024, Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel (Rammel) was at Promedica Toledo Hospital when the involved juvenile, herein known as (KD), was transported to the hospital by Care Flight due to gunshot injuries sustained during an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) involving KD and the Findlay Police Department (FPD).

While at the hospital, SA Rammel made contact with multiple members of the nursing staff and doctors responsible for the treatment of KD. SA Rammel was informed that KD was not going to have surgery during the night of October 28, 2024, and that KD was going to be transferred to the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). SA Rammel left his contact information with the Promedica Police Department in order for the nursing staff to contact SA Rammel once it was determined when KD was going to have surgery so that the bullet fragments could be collected for evidence.

On October 29, 2024, SA Rammel was contacted by the In-Charge Nurse in the ICU and informed that KD had just died due to his injuries. SA Rammel inquired if KD was placed into the custody of the Lucas County Coroner's Office (LCCO) and was told that KD was still at the hospital but would be transferred to the LCCO shortly.

SA Rammel provided the updated information to SA Tiffany Najmulski.

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
