DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, submitting for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease, in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner, under the authority of section 471, General Code, to one R. R. Stalter of Nelsonville, Ohio.

This lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years, and which provides for an annual rental of \$12.00, payable semi-annually, grants and demises to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for docklanding and boathouse purposes only, that portion of the waterfront on the south shore of Buckeye Lake, commencing at a line drawn 20 feet east of the west line of Section 27, Town 17, Range 18, Fairfield County, Ohio, and extending thence easterly 32 feet including the full width of the berme embankment of said Buckeye Lake.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by R. R. Stalter, the lesses therein named.

I further find upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the provisions of the sections of the General Code above referred to, and with those of other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

APPROVAL, RESERVOIR LAND LEASE TO LAND AT LAKE LORAMIE, OHIO—EDWARD BAUMER OF MINSTER, OHIO.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, submitting for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease, in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner, under the authority of section 471, General Code, to one Edward Baumer of Minster, Ohio.

This lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years, and which provides for an annual rental of \$75.00, payable semi-annually, grants and demises to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for cottage sites and docklanding purposes only, that portion of the State Reservoir property at Lake Loramie, described as follows:

"Beginning at the stone that marks the northwest corner of Section 6, Town 8 South, Range 5 East, Shelby County, Ohio; thence east along the north line of said section 6, 300 feet, more or less, to the water line of Lake Loramie; thence southwesterly and northwesterly along the water line of Lake Loramie, 500 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning and containing, 9/10 acres of land, more or less."
