On April 20, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb retrieved evidence from the autopsy of Miles Jackson (Jackson). Jackson was shot and killed during an officer involved critical incident that occurred at Mount Carmel St. Ann's Hospital in Westerville, Ohio (see report: Processing of Trauma Bay).

SA Holcomb collected the evidence from the Franklin County Coroner's Office and transported the evidence to the BCI Offices located in London, OH. SA Holcomb labeled a sealed bag that contained the paper bag over Jackson's left hand as item #1. A sweatshirt, t-shirt, undershirt, hair ties, and socks that had suspected blood and suspected bullet holes were all photographed. All the clothing was collected as item #2. Small cardboard boxes that contained projectiles were collected as items #3-16. Jackson's fingernail scrapings and fingerprint cards were collected as item #17. Jackson's DNA blood card was collected as item #18.

At 1144 hours, SA Holcomb submitted items #3-16 to the BCI Laboratory.

At 1158 hours, SA Holcomb placed items #1, 2, 17 and 18 to the BCI temporary evidence locker to be submitted to the BCI evidence vault.
