APPROVAL, BONDS OF DARKE COUNTY, \$78,000, FOR ROAD  
IMPROVEMENTS.

Re: Bonds of Darke county, \$78,000, for the improvement of Section  
"E", I. C. H. 62, Dayton-Greenville road, 1 bond payable in 3 installments  
of \$10,000 each and 6 installments of \$8,000 each—6 per cent.

GENTLEMEN:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the county  
commissioners and other officers of Darke county, relative to the above bond issue  
and find the same regular and in conformity with the provisions of the  
General Code.

I am of the opinion that a bond for said issue with combined principal and  
interest coupons attached, drawn in accordance with the bond resolution authoriz-  
ing the same and in compliance with the resolution of the Industrial Commission  
adopted under authority of section 1465-58a G. C. will, upon delivery, constitute  
a valid and binding obligation of said county.

Since the purchase of the above bonds by the Industrial Commission, the amount  
and denomination thereof have been changed through amendment to the bond
