EASEMENT—TO STATE BY SEVERAL PROPERTY OWNERS,
LAND, WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, HARRISON COUNTY,
USE, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Washington Township, Harrison County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and county.
