Narrative:

On July 2, 2024, Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel (Rammel) reviewed Deputy Samuel Miller's (Miller) employment and disciplinary records pertaining to his employment with the Wood County Sheriff's Office (WCSO).

Miller has not had any disciplinary violations during the course of his employment with the WCSO.

Miller's unoccupied cruiser was struck by a semi on the side of the road on October 31, 2023, but Miller was not in the vehicle nor was he deemed to be at fault.

The employment and disciplinary records were attached to this investigation.

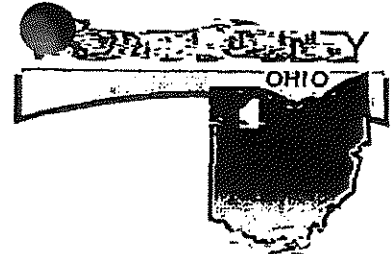

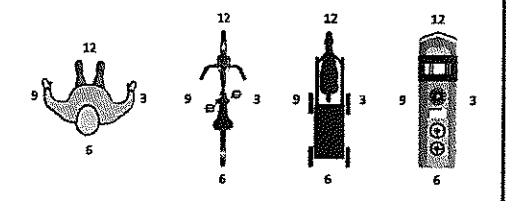

Tow Sheet not completed Unit #2 was towed to Wood County Garage.

The events of the crash were captured by Body Worn Camera of Deputy S. Miller as well as dash cam footage. Based on this footage Unit #1 is seen driving eastbound on US 20 after striking Unit #2 with the rear passenger side of the trailer. The semi appears to be a white cab, hauling a trailer that hauls gravel/dirt or things of that nature. The registration is not visible on the semi. The semi then continues eastbound and does not stop.

I spoke with the operator of Unit#2, identified as Deputy Miller, who stated he had parked his office issued vehicle on the eastbound lane to attempt and slow eastbound traffic. Deputy Miller stated he was standing outside of his vehicle trying to also slow vehicles down when he observed Unit #1 heading eastbound. He stated Unit 1 hit his brakes and then began losing control. The Semi then went into the westbound lane while the trailer was still sliding (eastbound) in the east bound lane. Deputy Miller stated the rear end of the trailer then struck Unit #2. Deputy Miller then observed Unit #1 continue east bound on US 20 without stopping.

Damage observed to Unit #2 was to the rear drivers side panel.

Roadway surface was blacktop, with ice.

A BOLO was issued to surrounding agencies with the description of Unit #1.

On October 31st 2023 I was dispatched to Fremont Pike and Lemoyne Rd, Troy Township, Wood County Ohio for a crash.

While in route Dispatch advised multiple vehicles were having trouble staying on the roadway due to the ice that had covered the bridge and roadway. Deputy Villegas was already on scene and advised she wanted me to respond to the West side of the bridge on Fremont Pike to help slow vehicles down.

I arrived on scene and made my way to the east side of the bridge. I activated my overhead lights and positioned my cruiser halfway in the eastbound lane of traffic and halfway in the emergency lane facing east at approximately the middle of the bridge. After a few cars went by, I noticed they were not slowing down. I observed a truck hit a patch of ice a couple yards east of my cruiser on the roadway. I observed the truck lose traction for a second then regain traction and continued eastbound on Fremont Pike. I repositioned my cruiser into the eastbound lane of travel to force vehicles to slow down before going around my cruiser. I got out of my cruiser and started walking west along the concrete barrier by the eastbound lane to use my flashlight in an attempt to get cars to slow down. I walked a couple yards and realized the bridge was completely covered in ice. I turned my flashlight on its strobe setting and started shining my light at cars that were traveling eastbound over the bridge vehicles did begin to slow down when I shined my flashlight at them.

As I was walking back to my cruiser, I observed a white tractor trailer semi traveling eastbound over the bridge and started shining my flashlight towards the semi. I observed the semi apply its brakes and start to slide. The semi attempted to steer into the westbound lane of Fremont Pike but the trailer continued to slide sideways in the eastbound lane. The tractor managed to steer into the westbound lane, but the back passenger side wheels of the trailer were still in the eastbound lane sliding sideways. I then observed the back passenger side tires of the trailer strike my cruiser. The tires struck the rear driver's side wheel of my cruiser and the rear side panel of my cruiser. After the semi struck my cruiser, I advised Dispatch my cruiser had been struck and advised Deputy Villegas to get out of the roadway due to the semi continuing eastbound. The semi continued past Deputy Villegas who's cruiser was sitting on the south side of the roadway at Fremont Pike and Lemoyne SE access Rd. The semi did not stop and continued eastbound on Fremont Pike.

The semi tractor was white in color and appeared to be a sleeper cab. The semi was hauling a grey trailer that appeared to be used for hauling gravel or dirt. I was not able to observe any markings on the tractor or the plate for the tractor or trailer. A BOLO was issued by Dispatch for the semi-truck and trailer.

My BWC was activated for this incident.

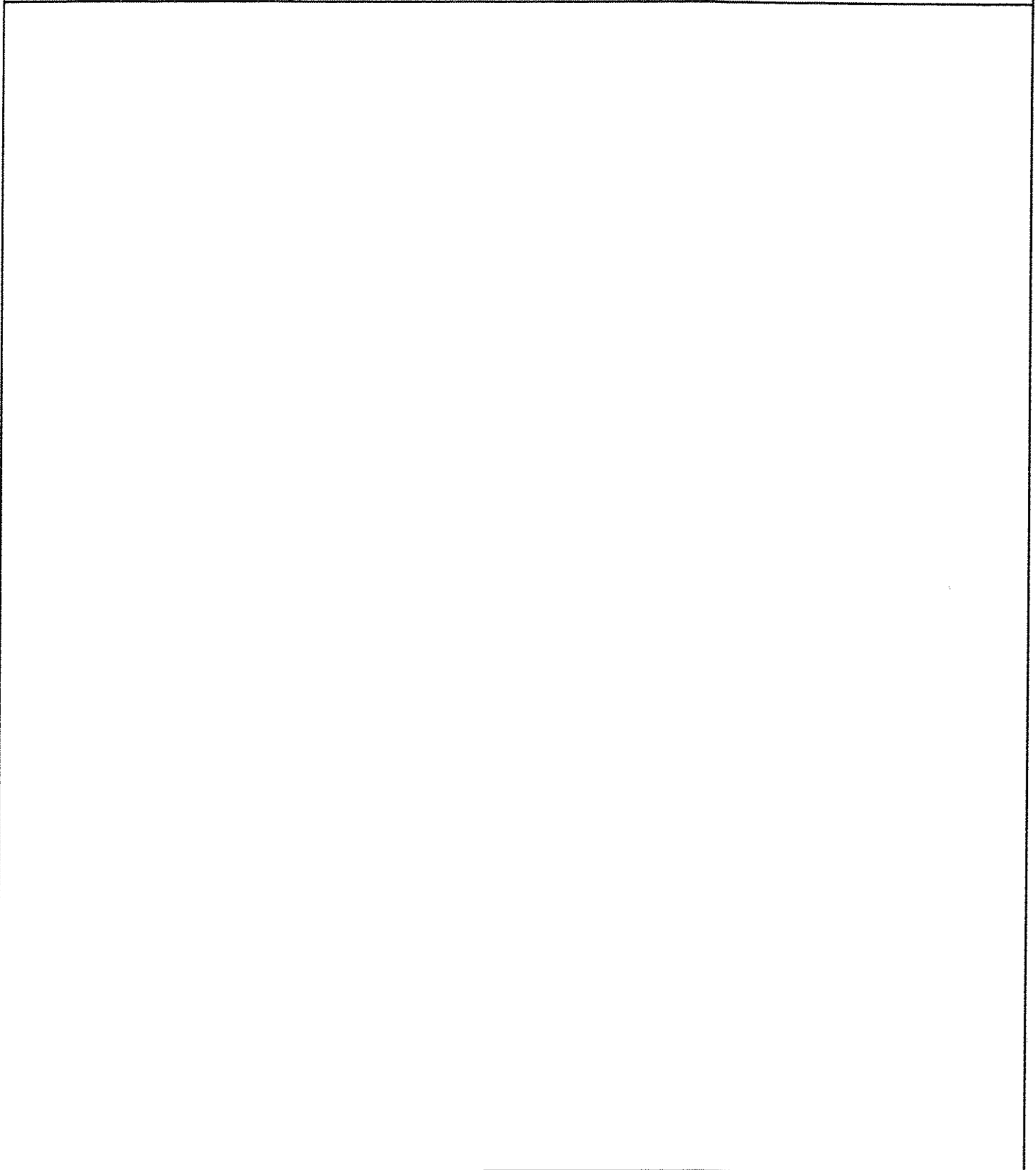
