Narrative:

On May 23, 2022, at 1550 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Steven Seitzman (SA Seitzman) conducted a phone interview with Brian Woolever (Mr. Woolever). Mr. Woolever was identified as a witness to the Officer-Involved Critical Incident on May 20, 2022, that took place at 947 SR-28 Business, Milford, Ohio (Berry Lane Apartments). Mr. Woolever provided a written statement to the Miami Township Police Department on May 20, 2022, indicating he witnessed a portion of the Officer-Involved Critical Incident.

The phone interview was recorded on a handheld digital recording device. The details below summarize the pertinent portions of the recorded interview and are not a verbatim account. Further, this report was placed in a chronology to aid the reader's overall understanding of the information elicited during the interview and may not be reflective of the actual sequencing of questions. It is suggested that the full audio recording be reviewed to clarify the content of the interview.

Mr. Woolever advised SA Seitzman of the following:

Mr. Woolever confirmed he completed a written statement and provided it to the Miami Township Police Department. He was inside Harky's Motorsports (944 Business 28, Milford, Ohio), which is situated on the north side of Business 28 across the street from the incident. While inside the shop, he heard two or three "pops." He initially assumed the sound was from firecrackers. He then saw three or four police vehicles arrive. The next thing he remembered was hearing the glass shattering in the store. He had his back to the window and estimated he was approximately ten feet from it at the time it shattered. He went to the back corner of the store and took cover. He remembered hearing another "pop," and then "rapid fire."

Once the shooting stopped, Mr. Woolever came out into the showroom with employees of

Harky's. He saw shattered glass on the ground. He also saw what he described as a bullet in the glass debris near one of the motorcycles, approximately five feet from the window. He observed another piece of a suspected bullet under a motorcycle in the center of the store. He advised no one inside the store touched the potential evidence.

Mr. Woolever confirmed he never saw the involved subject, Camille Artice Weems. He saw the responding police officers as they arrived. He heard the gunshots but never saw anyone firing a weapon.

Mr. Woolever advised he intended to contact the Miami Township Police Chief to tell him that he believed the officers saved lives.

The interview was concluded at 1557 hours. The audio recording is attached below. Also attached is the written statement Mr. Woolever provided to the Miami Township Police Department on May 20, 2022.
