Narrative:

On October 7, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (Bynum) reviewed the following items related to the June 1, 2024, officer-involved critical incident in Ashtabula County, Ohio:

- Audio recorded 911 calls
- Audio recorded radio traffic and data,
- Ashtabula County Sheriff's Office (ACSO) and Lake County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) reports

The documents and recordings were provided by Ashtabula County Sheriff's Office and Lake County Sheriff's Office. The recorded radio traffic and 911 calls have been stored in the BCI SIU case file as Reference Item F and G. The CPD CAD report has been uploaded to Matrix and attached to this report.

Audio recorded 911 Calls

The recorded 911 calls were provided in the following two files:



Each recorded call was reviewed. The following recordings were identified as being most relevant to this investigation:

1st 911 Call.wav

- A male caller who identified himself as Dwayne Turnquist (Turnquist) called 911 and reported that his wife, at 2125 Tryon Road, Ashtabula, Ohio, reported to him that the neighbor came outside with a rifle and pointed it at her. Turnquist

stated that his wife took the dog inside and called him. Turnquist further explained that the neighbor is in his late sixties and has had some health problems. Turnquist also said that a few weeks prior, the neighbor was yelling across the street.

2nd 911 Call.wav

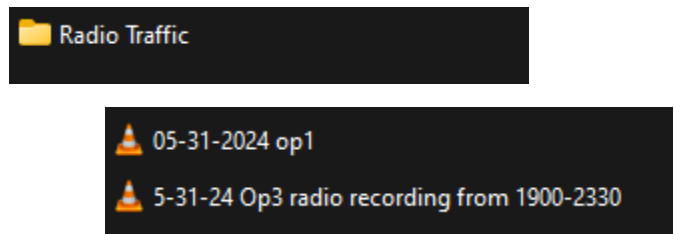
- Dwayne Turnquist (Turnquist) called 911 a second time. This time he stated that he had just returned home and the neighbor was outside with the rifle and the neighbor had it “zoomed in on (him)”. Turnquist stated that the neighbor’s name was John Terry and that deputies needed to be careful.

Audio Recorded Police Radio Traffic

The recorded radio traffic was provided in the following two folders:

Ashtabula County Sheriff’s Office



File *05-31-2024 op1.wav* was 00:29 in length and contained radio communication between ACSO dispatch and ACSO Deputies combined in one file. Dispatch asked if they were looking for a person named Nathan Lucarelli. The radio traffic ends with dispatch transferring the caller.

File *5-31-24 Op3 radio recording from 1900-2330.wav* was 04:28:04 in length and was radio communication between ACSO dispatch and deputies combined in one file. Dispatch sent deputies to 2125 Tryon Rd for a male with a gun pointing at neighbors. Deputies arrived and attempted to establish communication with the male. Unable to establish communication, they requested an entry team. This was just a summarized communication of the notable items from the dispatch / deputy communication shown below. There will be even further details in the original audio file.

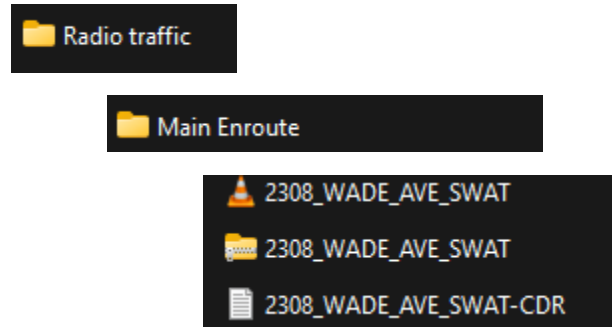

The *Radio traffic* folder contained two folders, with one labeled *Main Enroute* and one labeled *TAC 4 Incident*. In the Main traffic folder were three items labeled as *2308_WADE_AVE_SWAT.wav*, *2308_WADE_AVE_SWAT.zip*, and *2308_WADE_AVE_SWAT-CDR*. The file *2308_WADE_AVE_SWAT.wav* was 04:12 in length and was radio communication between Lake County Sheriff's Office requesting to start a car towards Ashtabula and that SWAT would be en route. The radio traffic also established SWAT would be using TAC 4 for the radio channel. The zip file contained the wav file and the CDR file.
