Narrative:

On September 29, 2021, Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Jim Mulford (SA Mulford) accompanied Columbus Division of Police (CPD) Sargent Terry McConnell (Sgt. McConnell) to conduct a death notification to John and Melody Veyon. This notification was regarding their adopted son, Kyle Veyon, who was involved in a fatal shooting with officers with the Columbus Division of Police on this date in the roadway at 2469 Kimberly Parkway E. in Columbus, Ohio.

At approximately 2100 hours, SA Mulford and Sgt. McConnell traveled to 14974 Township Road 202 in Corning, Ohio. The Veyon's were not home at the time, but ultimately agreed, by telephone, to meet at the Children's Services parking lot in New Lexington, OH.

During the notification, Melody Veyon reported Kyle had been diagnosed bipolar and had a long history of mental health issues and drug addiction. She stated she talked with Kyle this week and begged him to seek medical attention. His adoptive parents stated they were very concerned with Kyle's mental health status and drug addiction.

SA Mulford left a business card with the Veyon's advising them they could call with any follow-up questions or concerns.
