Narrative:

Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) obtained recent police reports involving Randall Fife from the Howland Township Police Department. SA Momchilov reviewed the reports and documented the following:

23-00397-January 15, 2023 -Offense/Type of Incident-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to Randall Fife hallucinating and making threats to harm the "man" impersonating his mother. Officers contacted Fife in the basement of the residence. Fife willingly exited the basement and advised that he was not carrying any weapons and gave consent for officers to search his person. Numerous knives were located on Fife's person. While officers were searching Fife, Fife tensed up, became increasingly agitated and refused to keep his right hand above his head. Fife was placed into handcuffs.

Fife's family members advised that Fife was hallucinating and that he did not take prescribed medications for multiple days. Fife's mother, [REDACTED] stated that Fife believes that she is a 'transgender imposter.' [REDACTED] also advised that she is concerned that Fife will attempt to harm her during "one of his episodes." Fife was ultimately pink slipped and transported to the Trumbull Regional Medical Center.

22-09604-December 17, 2022-Check Welfare

An employee of Coleman Behavioral Health had called and requested that the police department check the welfare of Randall Fife. The employee advised that they believe Fife was hallucinating, a firearm may be involved, and Fife might not be cooperative.

When officers arrived, Randall came to the back door, opened a curtain and looked at officers, and retreated back into the residence. Officers started to find cover when approximately a minute later Randall came to the back door again. He came out onto the back porch and was ordered to show his hands. He complied and was patted down for weapons. Randall was wearing large cargo pants with multiple pockets, and he had numerous folding knives (approximately 10) of all sizes in his pants pockets.

Fife was evaluated by members of Coleman Behavior Health. It was decided that Fife would be transported to the hospital and pink slipped.

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[REDACTED] February 25, 2022-Offense/Type of Incident-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in reference to Randall Fife, in a bathroom of the residence, armed with a knife, threatening suicide.

Officers arrived on scene and were met by Fife who was on the back porch of the residence, officers identified themselves and requested Fife bring his dogs inside as they appeared aggressive and would not allow officers to approach the doorway. Fife quickly retreated inside of the residence. [REDACTED] (Mother) then exited the residence and restrained the dogs so officers could enter. [REDACTED] advised that Randall had went back into the bathroom and to her knowledge still possessed a knife. [REDACTED] advised that Randall was intoxicated, possibly not taking his prescribed medications, and was most likely suffering from a [REDACTED] episode.

Officers contacted Fife and requested he exit the bathroom and display his hands to ensure he was not armed. Fife opened the door and stepped into the hallway. He had a lit cigarette in one hand and a can of beer in the other hand; officers asked if Fife would walk into the living room. Fife refused, and when asked if he had a knife on him, he stated he did but would not disclose where it was. Fife was visibly upset, he was crying and shaking, and repeated that he did "not want to fight" and did not want to "hurt us or anyone". Fife continued to pace back and forth between the shallow hallway and the bathroom door, while doing so, he advised that he did not intend on going to the hospital and would not go to jail either. Officers continued to speak with Fife and asked him to come into the living room to speak with us, Fife began to walk out of the hallway; however, he then struck an unattached door in the hallway which fell between officers and him, Fife went to retreat into the nearest bedroom but stumbled and fell onto the ground. Officers were able to grab ahold of Fife's arm and placed him into an escort position. Officers then escorted Fife into the living room area to speak with Howland Fire Medics. Officer Brancaccio, located a knife concealed in a sheath on Fife's right hip as well as a smaller folding knife in Fife's right front pocket.

Fife was transported to Trumbull Regional Medical Center and pink slipped.

[REDACTED] August 19, 2021-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a suicide/attempted suicide complaint. Randall Fife's mother, [REDACTED] called and stated Fife is diagnosed with [REDACTED] and that he is hearing voices. [REDACTED] stated that Fife was yelling at the

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voices, stating he will kill them and himself. Fife denied making any statements that he'd harm himself and denied hearing any voices. Several family members were on scene, and all advised that they witnessed it and they also had video of it. After speaking with Fife, he agreed to go to the hospital on his own freewill to be evaluated. Howland EMS transported Fife voluntarily to Trumbull Regional without incident.

[REDACTED] October 5, 2016-Domesitic Dispute

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] for a possible domestic, called in by a neighbor. Upon arrival, officers spoke with Randall Fife Sr (witness). Randall stated that his two sons (Randall Fife Jr and [REDACTED] got into a verbal argument, and everything was fine. Officers spoke with the two subjects and determined that it was only a verbal argument that ensued over personal issues and no threats of violence were made and nothing physical transpired.

15-0385-May 13, 2015-Unwanted Person

Officers were dispatched to 3090 Bolin Ave (JLB Trucking) in reference to two unwanted subjects, James Clay Jr and Randall Fife. Units arrived and spoke with the complainant (James Clay Sr.). Complainant advised that he came to this location to check on his semi-trucks and observed James Clay Jr and Randall Fife walking away from one of the vehicles. When they saw him, they took off running North on Bolin Ave. Complainant advised that neither Clay Jr or Fife have permission to be on his property and he does not want them there. All the vehicles were checked by the complainant, and all checked ok. Units checked the area for the subjects and were unable to locate them. The complainant was advised a report would be on file.

[REDACTED] June 17, 2014-Domestic Violence

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a possible domestic incident involving father and son.

Upon arrival Officers did not observe anyone outside of the residence and there were no answers at the door upon knocking and announcing our presence. Officers observed an open garage door to the residence. Upon checking the residence, Officers observed suspect Randall J. Fife in the living room area of the residence. Fife advised that he and his father got into a fight and his father left the residence to an unknown location. Officers detained Fife until the remainder of the residence was checked for other people. No other individuals were in the residence. [REDACTED] also arrived back at the residence with his wife, [REDACTED] who was attempting to take Mr. Fife to St. Joseph's hospital to get stitches for a cut above his left eye. Officers spoke to

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witness Kristina Molina and Mr. Fife who stated that they were at the residence having a birthday party for Mr. Fife's teenage daughter. Both stated that Fife came home intoxicated and started a verbal fight with a friend of Mr. Fife's daughter while in the living room area of the residence. Both stated that Fife picked up a wooden dining room chair and broke it out of anger. Both Mr. Fife and Kristina stated that [REDACTED] attempted to restrain Fife. Both stated that Fife picked up a wooden piece of the broken chair and struck [REDACTED] in the face, cutting him over his left eye. Kristina stated that she called 911 as everyone was leaving the residence. Fife was arrested for domestic violence.

[REDACTED] July 20, 2013-Domestic Violence

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a male, Randall Fife with mental issues, who had thrown a chair through a window then fled on foot.

Officers arrived on scene and spoke with the complainant [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that Fife was upset and started an argument with his brother [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that Fife slapped [REDACTED] across the face with an open hand and then picked up a dining room chair and threw it striking the dining room window, shattering it.

Officers spoke with [REDACTED] who stated that Fife started yelling at him about putting gum in an ashtray. [REDACTED] then stated that Fife slapped him with an open hand across the right side of his face. [REDACTED] told his parents what happened and when they confronted Fife, he threw a chair through the dining room picture window.

This officer checked the area for Fife and observed him walking South on Niles Rd. When he saw the officers, he took off running. Fife was eventually located and placed under arrest.

[REDACTED] November 11, 2012-Information

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to Fife threatening to harm his family and a female named "Ashley". Officers arrived and spoke with the complainant [REDACTED]. The complainant advised that his son Randall Fife Jr is going through some hard times and needs to go to the hospital for a mental evaluation. The complainant also advised that Fife made threats to harm himself. Officers then spoke with Fife who was highly upset and intoxicated. Fife advised that he trying to deal with many problems, and he can't handle it anymore. Howland EMS was called and transported Fife voluntarily to Trumbull Hospital for a mental evaluation.

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[REDACTED] October 11, 2010-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to the suspect, Randall Fife, who had a knife and was threatening suicide. Upon the officer's arrival, Fife was sitting in a living room chair unarmed and crying. Fife's father, [REDACTED] advised that his son has mental problems and had gotten upset and agitated for no reason. Complainant advised that he had a knife to his wrist with the top of the knife blade (dull side) against his wrist. At that time, the complainant took the knife from Fife prior to the officers' arrival. Fife did not injure himself. He was transported to the hospital for a mental evaluation by the Howland Fire Department and pink slipped.

10-005637-January 26, 2010-Warrant Arrest

Randall Fife was arrested on an outstanding warrant.

[REDACTED] November 12, 2009-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a suicidal male, Randall Fife. Upon arrival officers spoke to Fife's parents who stated that Fife was off his medication, has mental issues and that Fife stated he wanted to kill himself.

Officers spoke to Fife about this incident. Fife stated that he did not want to go to the hospital, he just wanted to leave. Fife appeared to be intoxicated and emotionally upset/irate. Fife advised that he did not want to go to the hospital and attempted to run off the porch. Officers grabbed Fife and Fife became combative. Eventually Fife was handcuffed, transported to the hospital and pink slipped.

[REDACTED] December 31, 2007-Suicide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a suicide attempt. It was reported that Fife had ingested approximately 15 Depakote tablets. Fife was transported to the hospital.

[REDACTED] July 3, 2007-Domestic Violence-Resisting Arrest

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to Randall Fife causing a disturbance. Fife was arrested for striking his girlfriend, who he has a child with. Fife also threatened to kill his girlfriend's whole family.

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As Fife was being escorted from the house, he became verbal with his girlfriend, telling her not to sign the charges. The report states,

"While trying to escort Randall out of the house, he became verbal with [REDACTED] telling her not to sign the charges. Randall then pulled away from me and began to walk towards [REDACTED] yelling for her not to sign the charges. I gave Randall verbal commands to stop and walk outside. Randall ignored me and still continued to pull away from me. Due to Randall not responding my commands, I drive stunned Randall with a X26 taser to his right rear shoulder area. Randall then fell to the ground. I then advised Randall to stand up because we are going outside. I also advised Randall to remain quiet and not to say anything else to [REDACTED]. Once Randall stood up he began yelling at [REDACTED] and started to pull away from me once again. I grabbed Randall by his right arm and began to escort him out of the house once again. Randall pulled away from me and started to walk towards [REDACTED] yelling. I advised Randall that I was going to use the Taser if he did stop walking. Due to Randall not responding to my commands, I drive stunned Randall in the center of his back. Randall then fell to the floor.

Randall then advised that he would stop and go outside. Once outside at patrol unit 25, I opened the door and advised Randall to have a seat. Randall began to sit down and then stoop up and stated, "fuck you, I am not sitting down". Randall took a step towards me at which time I drive stunned with the Taser in his mid section. Randall then sat down in the rear of patrol unit 25. Randall then started to kick his feet at me at which point I drive stunned him on his upper leg area. Randall then calmed down and I was able to secure him in my patrol unit.

Randall was then transported to Howland PD for booking. After the booking process, Randall was transported to the Trumbull County Jail for incarceration."

07-016313-March 15, 2007- Felonious Assault-Weapon or Ordnance.

The only information provided in the report is as follows:

"Officers were dispatched to the 2700 block of Orchard Ave regarding shots fired. R/o was approached by listed victim Corwyn Jennings who stated that he heard gunshots near his residence. Investigation followed."

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07-016595-March 15, 2007-Warrant Arrest

Randall Fife was arrested on an outstanding warrant.

07-015653-March 11, 2007-Petty Theft-Criminal Damaging

Officers were dispatched to Super K-Mart in reference to a disturbance at the front doors. Randall Fife was observed walking past all points of sales with two bottles of liquor. Loss prevention attempted to apprehend Fife at which point a brief struggle ensued. Eventually, Fife was able to be subdued.

07-007978-February 5, 2007-Sucide or Attempted Suicide

Officers were dispatched to 2740 Orchard Ave in regards Randall Fife cutting himself with a knife. Upon officers arrive, Fife was placed into handcuffs and stated he had cut himself with a knife. Fife was transported to the hospital.

[REDACTED] Feburary 12, 2005-Juvenile Runaway

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a runaway juvenile. Complainant [REDACTED] advised that her son, Randall Fife, left the house on February 15, 2005, at 1700 hours. [REDACTED] advised that Randall has a medical condition consisting of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also advised that Randall needs to take his medication. Fife requested that Randell be transported to North Side Youth Service Unit if apprehended. Fife advised that he could possibly be headed to Niles around the Royal Mall apartments or Youngstown. Fife was entered as a missing/runaway juvenile.

04-039745-October 9, 2004-Criminal Damage, Obstructing Official Business, Complicity

Officers were dispatched to the corner of Overlook and Flory in reference to three white male juveniles spray-painting the roadway.

Randall Fife was listed as a suspect in that report. Officers contacted Fife who denied any involvement.

[REDACTED] PF-June 25, 2004-Arrest, Unruly Juvenile, Detainer, Burglary/Criminal Trespass

The narrative of the report reads:

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"OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO [REDACTED] IN REGARDS TO RANDAL FIFE (ARRESTEE) BEING INVOLVED IN A DISTURBANCE WITH A NEIGHBOR. ON ARRIVAL R/O SPOKE TO LISA A REESMAN (COMPLAINANT) WHO STATED RANDAL CAME ONTO HER PROPERTY, YELLING AND SWEARING AT HER. RANDALS PARENTS ALSO ADVISED OFFICERS RANDAL IS CURRENTLY UNDER HOUSE ARREST. TC 911 CENTER ADVISED OFFICERS RANDAL HAD A DETAINER OUT FOR AGG MENACING, AGG BURGLARY, CRIMINAL TRESPASS. R/O ARRESTED RANDAL TRANSPORTED HIM TO HPD FOR BOOKING AND THEN TO JJC. R/O WILL FILE UNRULY CHARGES AT JJC."

04-1040PF-April 21, 2004-Arrest, Detainer, Probation Violation

The narrative of the report reads:

"OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO THE AREA OF BOSTON SE IN REGARDS TO RANDALL FIFE (ARRESTEE) HAD BEEN ISSUED A DETAINER FOR HIS PICKUP AND HAD BEEN SEEN WALKING IN THE AREA. ON ARRIVAL OFFICERS BEGAN TO CHECK THE AREA. R/O OBSERVED A WHITE MALE WALKING THROUGH THE YARDS OF RAVENWOOD. R/O WAS ABLE TO IDENTIFY THE WHITE MALE TO BE RANDALL AND PLACED HIM UNDER ARREST AT THE CORNER OF RAVENWOOD AND ALLYSON. R/O TRANSPORTED RANDALL TO JJC. JJC ADVISED THEY WOULD CONTACT RANDALLS PARENTS. OFFICERS: NICKLOW, RUMANCIK, GARRETSON"

[REDACTED] April 21, 2004-Unruly Juvenile, Runaway Juvenile

Randall Fife's mother, [REDACTED] reported that Fife left the residence on April 20, 2004, and did not return.

04-009911-June 8, 2004-Mentally Impaired Person

Officers were dispatched to 3454 Ridgelawn in reference to a "mentally impaired person. Officers contacted Randall Fife who stated, "Why are you tapping my phone and listening to my grandmother's voice?" Fife was placed into handcuffs and transported to Northside Hospital for a psychiatric evaluation.

Officers later learned that prior to contacting Fife, it was reported that Fife attempted to enter a residence forcefully and stated, "Let me in, people are after me. Don't worry I won't hurt you; I don't have gun." Fife then took off running after the complaint slammed the door on him.

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04-714PF-March 19, 2004-Arrest, Disorderly Conduct, Curfew Violation, Underage Possession of Tobacco

Officers were on the scene of an overdose complaint at 3556 Ridgelawn Avenue. Officer observed Randall Fife, walking through the front yard.

The officer noted in the report that Fife had a history of violating curfew and leaving his house without permission. Officers contacted Fife's mother who stated she told Fife not to leave but he did so anyway. The report also stated that Fife lied about his age. Fife was instructed to go back to his residence but refused. Fife was placed under arrest at which point he began "to use vulgar language." Fife was later released to his mother's custody.

[REDACTED] June 1, 2003-Unruly Juvenile

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to an unruly juvenile complaint. Complainant [REDACTED] reported that her son Randall Fife left the house without permission.

[REDACTED] May 5, 2003-Unruly Juvenile

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to an unruly juvenile complaint. It was reported that Randall Fife became upset and "Started destroying his bedroom."

02-064226-October 2, 2002-Unruly Juvenile

Randall Fife was reported as missing/runaway juvenile. Fife was later located at 297 Shaffer and released to his parents.

On the listed date and time, officers were dispatched to [REDACTED]. Officers were advised that Randall Fife (Victim #1) was hallucinating and making homicidal threats to family members. Fife was at home with another sibling and his mother and sister advised that they would meet with officers outside of the residence. Ptl. Wert spoke with [REDACTED] (Mother) via public service while en route to the residence. [REDACTED] advised officers that Randall was hallucinating and did not believe that she was his mother, [REDACTED] stated that Randall made a threat to harm the "man" impersonating his mother.

Officers arrived on scene and were greeted at the front door by [REDACTED] and Maxine Fife spoke with officers in the driveway. [REDACTED] allowed officers to enter the home and advised that Randall was currently in the basement. Officers requested Randall walk up the stairs and speak outside. Randall willingly exited the residence where officers asked if Randall was carrying any knives, he advised that he did not have any weapons on his person. I, Ptl. Brancaccio, asked if Randall would give consent to searching his pockets for any knives (it is officer's knowledge that Randall carries numerous knives on him based off of previous dealings with him). Randall gave consent and I located numerous knives inside of his pants pockets as well as concealed in a sheath on his belt. Randall stated that he knew [REDACTED] was his mother and that he wished to go to another family member's residence for the night.

While searching Randall, he began to tense up, became increasingly agitated, and refused to keep his right hand above his head; therefore, officers placed him in handcuffs for safety reasons. Randall was escorted to the rear of a Howland Fire Department ambulance, while walking from the residence, Randall continued to argue with officers about the grounds for a pink slip. Randall was released from handcuffs inside of the ambulance and transported to Trumbull Regional Medical Center. Ptl. Wert followed and signed a Pink Slip on Randall.

I then spoke with Randall's family members on scene. ██████ advised that he was sitting on the couch next to Randall when Randall asked ██████ "if he would be upset if he killed that guy sitting on the couch?" ██████ stated to Randall that no one was sitting next to them and then Randall replied that he intended to harm the "guy pretending" to be ██████ Randall then stated that ██████ was an "imposter" and not his mother. At that point, ██████ sent a text message to ██████ and Maxine advising the two not to return to the residence based on Randall's comments. ██████ and Maxine then contacted TC 911 Center. While on scene, Maxine also produced video recordings of Randall speaking to hallucinations and carrying on in conversations.

It was ultimately determined that Randall would be transported to Trumbull Regional Medical Center for a mental evaluation. It was stated by family members that Randall was hallucinating, he did not take prescribed medications for multiple days, he thought a male was inside of the residence pretending to be his mother (██████) and Randall told his brother, ██████ that he was going to kill him (the male who was in the house pretending to be ██████). ██████ stated that Randall believes she is a "transgender imposter" and she is not even his mother. ██████ is concerned that Randall will attempt to harm her during one of his episodes. She stated that Randall returned from a psychiatric hospital in Columbus and was fine for a few days but returned to acting how he was previously. He has been yelling and screaming again. He

stated to [REDACTED] "what did you do with my mom?", "you are a demon", and "I should just kill you and bury you in the backyard". Kerri stated that there were no firearms in the residence. I briefly talked to Maxine, Randall's sister, and she stated that she is pregnant with a boy. They were talking today and stated that her future son looks funny on the ultrasound. She stated that Randall started to talk to himself and state "I bet he just thinks he is so fucking funny, I bet he does". Maxine is also concerned about [REDACTED] because Randall told [REDACTED] that he is going to "kill whoever this imposter is" in reference to not knowing who [REDACTED] is. In talking with Randall, he started to become irate with officers and would not leave his hands where he was told to. He was briefly detained in handcuffs and escorted to the ambulance. Randall was intoxicated and continued to yell and scream and stated to officers "you can't prevent anything from happening" and "you are just starting trouble". Multiple knives were recovered from Randall's pants pockets and were turned over to family at the residence. I, Ptl. Wert, followed the ambulance to Trumbull Regional Medical Center where a pink slip was signed for Randall. I then cleared.

Fife opened the door and stepped into the hallway, he had a lit cigarette in one hand and a can of beer in the other hand, officers asked if Fife would walk into the living room. Fife refused, and when asked if he had a knife on him, he stated he did but would not disclose where it was at. Fife was visibly upset, he was crying and shaking, and repeated that he did "not want to fight" and did not want to "hurt us or anyone". Fife continued to pace back and forth between the shallow hallway and the bathroom door, while doing so, he advised that he did not intend on going to the hospital and would not go to jail either. Officers continued to speak with Fife and asked him to come into the living room to speak with us, Fife began to walk out of the hallway; however, he then struck an unattached door in the hallway which fell between officers and him, Fife went to retreat into the nearest bedroom but stumbled and fell onto the ground. Officers started to find cover when approximately a minute later Randall came to the back door again. He came out onto the back porch and was ordered to show his hands. He complied and was patted down for weapons. Randall was wearing large cargo pants with multiple pockets and he had numerous folding knives (approximately 10) of all sizes in his pants pockets. The knives were seized and when asked, Randall stated that he did not have any firearms on him. Emma and Christina came to the back door and evaluated Randall. Routine questions were asked and it was determined that Coleman Behavioral Health would be admitting Randall into the hospital and would be signing a pink slip. Randall stated that he did not want to go to the hospital but cooperated. He retrieved a hooded sweatshirt and shoes from the kitchen and was escorted by officers. There appeared to be multiple dogs in the residence who were aggressive. Randall was then escorted to the street.

NARRATIVE: Officer advised by victim that his fourteen year old son has not been seen or heard from since 0630 hours 10/02/02.
