Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 03, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (Burke) and SA Tiffany Najmulski (Najmulski) interviewed Lead Security Officer Ryan Parsons (Ryan) of Findlay City Schools (FCS) to gather information of a potential associate of Kalvin Darapheth (Kalvin). The interview took place at 1200 Broad Ave., Findlay, OH 45840. The purpose of the interview was to identify an associate of Kalvin, who had been observed in photographs with Kalvin, being in possession of a firearm.

SA Burke asked Ryan if he was familiar with Kalvin. Ryan stated he was familiar with Kalvin, but did not see him much due to him being enrolled at the on-line institution of the Findlay Digital Academy (FDA). SA Burke explained to Ryan, Kalvin had been in some photographs with an associate in possession of a firearm and wanted to see if Ryan could identify this associate. Ryan said he would observe the photograph to see if he could identify this said subject.

SA Burke presented Ryan with the following photographs.

In the above photograph to the left, Ryan stated this to be Connor Fleck (Connor) in the white shirt to be possession of a firearm. In the picture to the right, Ryan stated this to be Kalvin Darapheth in a blue hoodie to be in possession of a firearm. The firearm is documented with a yellow circle to the left and a yellow oval to the right.



Kalvin Darapheth Connor Fleck

SA Burke then presented the above picture to Ryan without a firearm being present. Ryan identified the subject to the left as Kalvin and the subject to the right as Connor. Ryan explained to Agents, Connor has been incarcerated at the Wood County Juvenile Detention Center (WCJDC) since September 20, 2024. This information was confirmed with WCJDC on Connor's book-in date.

Throughout this investigation, the firearm which was associated with the above photographs was confirmed **NOT** to be the same firearm which Kalvin had in possession at the time of the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) on October 28, 2024.

Agents did not have any other relevant questions for Ryan.
