#### **SUMMARY:**

On May 8, 2024, at 2054hrs, BCI Special Agent Laurna McClintock and Crime Scene technician Micheal Rostocil assisted Lieutenant Pat West and the North Ridgeville Police Department with the processing of an outdoor scene located at 4802 James Rd. North Ridgeville, Ohio, 44039 in regard to an Officer Involved Critical Incident. The scene was photographed as it was found, and evidence was collected. The scene was further documented using a Leica BLK360 laser scanner and small unmanned aircraft system. The scene was processed with consent given by the homeowner.

#### **DETAILS:**

On May 8, 2024, at 1954hrs, SA McClintock was contacted by SAS Lulla and was requested to assist Lt. Pat West and the North Ridgeville Police Department with the processing of an outdoor scene in regard to an Officer Involved Critical Incident.

On May 8, 2024, around 2100hrs, SA McClintock and CST Rostocil arrived at 4802 James Rd. North Ridgeville, Ohio, 44029. SA McClintock was briefed by LT. Lee with the North Ridgeville Police department. Lt. Lee stated the subject (Jason L. Norris, DOB: 03-27-1983, W/M) was standing in the driveway of the above address. Norris fired at least once at the officers before the officers fired at the subject. The officers were posted in two different areas. One officer was to the north of the subject in the back yard of 4801 Ronald Dr. North Ridgeville, Ohio. The second officer was to the east of the subject near an electrical pole in between 4784 James Rd. and 4762 James Rd. Prior to our arrival North Ridgeville placed caution tape around the scene.

The scene was photographed as found and examined for items of suspected evidence. Three separate areas of evidence were located, the two areas where the Officers were located described above and the driveway and yard of 4802 James Rd. The area where one officer was located, near the electric pole and bush located between addresses 4784 James Rd. and 4762 James Rd, produced one F. C. 223 Rem fired cartridge case under the bush and labeled **evidence** #1.

The second area was the driveway and yard of 4802 James Rd. In this area seven items of suspected evidence were located and photographed as is. Located in the yard was a black pistol, SCCY CPX-2 (SN:723802). The pistol had one round in the chamber, Blazer 9mm Luger, and nine rounds in the magazine. Within the magazine were two types of ammunition, Blazer 9mm Luger and F.C. 9mm Luger. The pistol was labeled **evidence** #2. In the driveway, a fired F.C. 9mm Luger cartridge case was located and labeled #3. A key fob, green lighter, a Hexabar vape, and a package of cigarettes was located and labeled #4-7. The last item located in the driveway was a camo Columbia hat. The hat was labeled #8. Items #4-8 are believed to be personal belongings of the subject.

The last area located was in the back yard of 4801 Ronald Dr. The officer was on the east side of the garage located at the above address. One F.C. 223 Rem fired Cartridge case was located and labeled #9.

Two suspected ballistic impacts were located on the fence in the back yard of 4802 James Rd. and labeled BI 1.0 and 1.1. These were photographed. The bullet traveled from the north, BI 1.1, towards the south, BI 1.0. The impacts were labeled incorrectly and should be swapped.

The scene was further documented by CST Rostocil using Leica BLK360 scanner. Scan data was prepared for viewing using the Leica Register360 software. Using the Leica Map360 software overheard diagrams were created (figure #6).

All items of evidence were turned over to BCI's special investigations unit to be held as evidence. An Inventory / Receipt Attachment form was filled out and signed by SA McClintock and SA Armstrong, a copy of the form was left with SA Armstrong for their records.
