"Lotteries and the sale of lottery tickets shall be prohibited on and after November 10, 1937, unless such Lottery is operated by the State."

The summary of this proposed amendment reads as follows:

"Amends Section 6 of Article XV of the Constitution of Ohio to permit the State of Ohio to operate a lottery. The Amendment becomes effective November 10, 1937."

I am of the opinion that the foregoing summary is a fair and truthful statement of the proposed amendment to the Constitution and accordingly submit for uses provided by law the following certification:

"Without passing upon the advisability of the adoption of the proposed amendment to the Constitution of Ohio and without passing upon the legality of same, but pursuant to the duties imposed upon me under the provisions of Section 4785-175, General Code, I hereby certify that the foregoing summary is a fair and truthful statement of the proposed amendment of Section 6 of Article XV of the Constitution of Ohio.
