DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a contract between The State of Ohio acting through you as Director of the Department of Public Works for the Board of Trustees of the Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio, and John C. Carroll and Clarence J. Trapp, Partners, doing business as Trapp-Carroll Company, of Columbus, Ohio for the construction and completion of General Contract (Division 1), together with Alternate No. 3, for the Addition to Physical Education Building on the Campus of the Ohio State University, as set forth in the General Conditions and the specifications for same, including Addendum No. 1, dated October 16, 1939, and as covered by form of proposal dated October 26, 1939, submitted by said party of the first part, which form of proposal is made a part of this contract.

Finding said contract in proper legal form, I have noted my approval thereon, and same is transmitted herewith to you, together with all other papers submitted in this connection.
