On August 30, 2023 Special Agent Cory Momchilov submitted one cellular phone to the Cyber Crime Unit for forensic analysis. The cellular phone was recovered during an investigation into an officer-involved critical incident (OICI). The accompanying search warrant was signed by the Honorable Judge Tammy O'Brien of the Summit County Court of Common Pleas for the criminal offenses of Obstructing Official Business-2921.31, Felonious Assault- 2903.11, Kidnapping-2905.01 and Domestic Violence-2915.25 in violation of the Ohio Revised Code.
