DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the state of Ohio, acting by the department of highways and public works, and Boyajohn & Barr, of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the general contract for fireproofing and alterations to McGuffey Training School Building, Miami university, Oxford, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of \$8,100.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the director of finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract.
