

Said section 5195, General Code, is one of the general statutes of the state and therefore the exemption from jury duty, therein provided for, is now in force and effect and will continue to be in force and effect until repealed by the legislature. This is made so by the specific terms of the act in question.

I am therefore of the opinion that contributing members of the Ohio National Guard are, and will continue to be, exempted from jury duty until such time as the provisions of law providing for such exemption are repealed by an act of legislation.
