**Narrative:**

On Wednesday, October 15, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) received training records from Trumbull County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) Captain John Elberty for [REDACTED]. SA Lamping reviewed the training records and noted the following:

Range Qualification Records

TCSO records indicate that [REDACTED] participated in a firearms qualification on August 14, 2025. He passed the qualification with his agency-issued Glock 22 bearing serial number [REDACTED].

Personnel File

A review of [REDACTED] personnel file did not reveal any major disciplinary issues related to use of force incidents. Two commendations and several notices of discipline were located in the file.

[REDACTED] file did not contain any mention of his involvement in an Officer Involved Critical Incident from [REDACTED]; however, it should be noted that BCI investigated the incident. The investigation was reviewed by the Trumbull County Prosecutor's Office who issued the following decision<sup>1</sup>:

*Because this office finds that there can be no other conclusion other than the fact that the officers' use of force was reasonable there will*


Please accept this letter as a letter of general commendation for the work performed by Detectives Mike Yannucci and Jolene Marcello, Sargent Robert Ross, and Deputies Lee Padula, and [REDACTED] in connection with the above referenced matter. As you will recall, Mr. Day shot his girlfriend, and murdered her mother in Mesopotamia, and he then fled to Roaming Shores, where he was apprehended a short time later. The responding officers, Sgt. Ross, and Deps. Padula and [REDACTED] immediately secured the crime scene located in the roadway of Kinsman Rd. (SR 87), ensuring that evidence was not destroyed, including 13 shell casing. They also obtained then names and address of potential witnesses, and learned where Mr. Day was headed, which resulted in his prompt apprehension. They then transported the Defendant to Trumbull County. During this trip, the Defendant made several unsolicited, incriminating statements, which your officers recorded using the vehicles audio/video recorder.

Detectives Yannucci and Marcello then assumed the lead, including requesting assistance from the Trumbull County Homicide Task Force, whose members were assigned various tasks. Det. Yannucci interrogated the Defendant, obtaining assorted admissions from him, while at the same time documenting that the Defendant's statement was made knowingly and voluntarily. Det. Marcello was tasked with interviewing various witnesses, including the Defendant's mother and step-father, as well as the deceased's boy-friend, who was on the phone with her when she was shot. Each of these pieces to the prosecution puzzle was key to the successful prosecution of this case.

Ultimately, Mr. Day he pleaded guilty as charged (Aggravated Murder and Attempted Aggravated Murder, each with a gun specification.) He waived his pre-sentence investigation and was sentenced to life imprisonment, with parole eligibility after serving 23 years.

As such, the above named officers deserve praise for their professionalism and respective investigative efforts.
