**Narrative:**

On June 22, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran received a USB flash drive from Lordstown Police Department (LPD) Captain Chris Bordonaro (Bordonaro). The flash drive contained the following items:

- Bazetta PD - Farmer Jims Indoor Soccer
- Liberty Township PD Information
- Lordstown PD Information
- 20230324121004
- Brookfield Tow Sheet - From Lordstown Pursuit
- Lake County Warrant and Report
- Mentor Warrant and Report

SA Moran reviewed the items and noted the following:

- Bazetta PD - Farmer Jims Indoor Soccer

This folder contained images from surveillance video from Farmer Jim's Sports Complex located at 2971 Niles Cortland Rd NE, Cortland, Ohio 44410. The images showed Fred Wild III (Wild) parking his black Dodge truck in the parking lot and Wild entering the complex. The video timestamp was March 19, 2023 at about 1951 hours.

There was a document from the Bazetta Police Department (BPD) of a call-for-service on March 8, 2023 at 1530 hours. The call number was#BAZ2300805 and the call was for an unknown problem.

Wild's son, Mason Baumbach (Bambauch), called the BPD about Wild driving around a lake in his truck and possibly being suicidal.

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- Liberty Township PD Information

There was a video labeled, "AshleyKitchen\_202303181221\_Car03\_63707718." This was in-car camera (ICC) video from the Liberty Township Police Department (LTPD) of an incident involving Wild on March 18, 2023 at about 1220 hours. This incident appeared to a vehicle pursuit of a black, 2010 Dodge Ram truck likely driven by Wild.

There was another video labeled, "ChristianThoma\_202303181211\_WFN1005306\_23960026." The officer approached the residence and a younger white male, possibly Mason Bambauch, said that Wild left in his black, Dodge Ram truck.

There was another video labeled, "ChristianThoma\_202303181211\_WFN1005306\_23960027." The officer approached the residence and a younger white male, possibly Mason Bambauch, said that Wild came to the residence and he should not be at the residence. Baumbach said Wild did not have a plate on his truck because he recently was arrested for a DUI. Wild wanted Baumbach to go with him and drive around Girard Lake "really fast."

There was a LTPD incident report from an incident on March 18, 2023 at 1200 hours. The LTPD incident number was 23-0002901 and it was regarding an unwanted person at a residence. Wild's son, Baumbach, contacted the LTPD about Wild being at his residence and having an active warrant.

There were multiple radio traffic recordings from an incident on March 18, 2023. There was a recorded call from Baumbach at 969 Keefer Road about Wild being at his residence and having a warrant.

There was a copy of the warrant filed with the Girard Municipal Court on March 20, 2023. The warrant was for Wild for Failure to Comply with Order or Signal of Police Officer from the incident that occurred on March 18, 2023.

- Lordstown PD Information

There were two recorded dispatch calls to the Lordstown Police Department (LPD) from a female at 8447 Tod Avenue regarding Wild being an unwanted person at the property and he was refusing to leave.

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There was an LPD incident report from an incident on March 20, 2023 at 1405 hours. The LPD incident number was 23-00131 and it was regarding and unwanted person at a business. The business owner indicated that Wild was not wanted on the property and refused to leave. The incident later changed to a vehicle pursuit with Wild.

There was another LPD incident report from the incident in Brookfield Township on March 21, 2023 at 0020 hours. The LPD incident number was 23-00133 and it was regarding assisting the Brookfield Township Police Department with locating Wild.

There was an ICC video from the LPD labeled, "Patrolman Ken Metz\_20230320\_02\_12\_car38\_UNCATEGORIZED\_77105832" that showed the incident and vehicle pursuit with Wild in his truck. The pursuit lasted a significant amount of time (over 30 minutes) and Wild fled from the LPD at a high rate of speed throughout a large portion of the pursuit.

There was an audio recorded interview conducted by LPD Captain Bordonaro and LPD Officer (Ofc.) Metz with the business owner, Richard Proverbs (Proverbs). The interview occurred on March 21, 2023 at 1018 hours.

Proverbs said Wild applied for a carpentry job with his company in 2019. He said Wild was in trouble multiple times for DUIs and it affected his employment because he was in jail. Proverbs employed Wild when he was not a “loose cannon” and “reckless” with his drinking. Wild did “odd things” and talked about “weird stuff like building submarines.” Proverbs said Wild’s son, Baumbach, recently told him that Wild was supposed to be taking medication. Proverbs said Wild has not been employed by his company since October or November of 2022.

Wild told Proverbs that he was dating a female named “Katy” and she lived in Mentor, Ohio. Proverbs said Katy recently showed up at his business in the last week to get keys made for Wild’s truck. Proverbs said Wild stayed in different locations. Wild sometimes stayed with his mother in Girard, Ohio and he sometimes stayed in a camper on Proverbs’ property. Proverbs said he did not have any issues with Wild as an employee of his company.

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Proverbs said Wild came back to his company at the end of February 2023 and worked for four days. Wild left for the weekend and did not return. Proverbs checked court websites and learned that Wild had been arrested for a DUI in Mentor, Ohio. Proverbs called Wild after he was released and Wild did not answer and did not return any calls. Proverbs said Wild's phone number was [REDACTED]

Proverbs stated Wild "showed up unannounced" about a week before March 20, 2023. Wild "sporadically" helped Proverbs and some other employees with working on Proverbs' house. Proverbs approached Wild and mentioned that he was not completing work tasks. Wild "disappeared" for a couple days and he called another employee, Jeff Fox (Fox), and told him that he ran out of gas. Proverbs spoke with Wild and Wild was "crying" about his truck running out of gas. Wild said his truck was going to be towed and he needed Proverbs to lend him money for the tow. Fox picked Wild up and brought him back to Proverbs' property. Proverbs met Wild and said they could go fill up his truck with gas. Wild said he also lost the keys to the truck. Proverbs arranged for Wild's truck to be towed back to his business.

A few days later, Katy came to Proverbs' business and said she was looking for Wild. Proverbs found Wild "passed out" in his truck on the business property. Wild had been drinking at a local bar. Proverbs spoke with Wild and he said he was probably going back to Mentor with Katy. Proverbs left and returned a short time later. Proverbs saw Wild and Katy and Wild said he was going to the hospital because he broke his hand.

In the days after that incident, Wild continuously was found asleep on a couch inside Proverbs' business. Proverbs said Wild was drunk and passed out. On March 17, 2023, Proverbs paid Wild for the work he performed and told Wild to leave the business. Proverbs believed that Wild went to a local bar and paid his tab.

On March 19, 2023, Wild texted Proverbs and said he was staying at an Airbnb. Wild sent a photo of a structure with green foam insulation (likely the cabin on Brian Adkins' property). Proverbs said Wild texted him so much that he silenced his notifications.

On March 20, 2023, Proverbs saw Wild's truck at his business. Proverbs went inside and saw Wild asleep on the couch. Proverbs told Wild that he could not stay there and had to leave. Proverbs left and returned a short time later and Wild's truck was there, but he could not find Wild. Proverbs left the business and later received a text from another employee that Wild was at the business.

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Proverbs returned to his business at about 1400 hours and Wild was “ranting and raving.” Proverbs told Wild he had to leave or he would call the police. He provided Wild with some gas for his truck and Wild was screaming at him about paying him for work that he did not do that day. Proverbs asked Wild what work he performed for payment and Wild “lost it.” Wild was “throwing tools” and was “freaking out.” Proverbs was not scared of Wild, but he was worried about the safety of his family.

Proverbs spoke about some past incidents involving Wild. Proverbs said Wild was arrested for throwing something through a window at a Menards store. He was also involved in a pursuit in Liberty Township a few days before the incident on March 20, 2023. Proverbs said Wild possibly had a “musket” because that was the only firearm he could legally own. Proverbs said Wild told him stories over the past several years. He recalled a story about Wild driving his truck through his house while he was getting divorced. Proverbs said Wild “hated” his ex-wives.

This folder appeared to have the same recorded call from the LPD that was described above.

- Brookfield Tow Sheet - From Lordstown Pursuit

This form was previously collected by SA Moran on March 21, 2023. It was a tow receipt from the Brookfield Township Police Department (BTPD) for Wild’s 2010 Dodge truck on March 20, 2023, when it was towed after the vehicle pursuit.

- Lake County Warrant and Report

This form was previously collected by SA Moran on March 21, 2023. This document was the warrant for Wild in Lake County, Ohio that was issued on March 15, 2023.

- Mentor Warrant and Report

This document was the warrant for Wild in Mentor, Ohio that was issued on March 13, 2023.

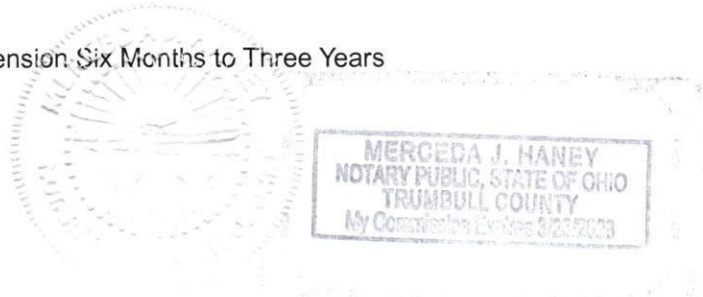

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On todays date I responded to 8447 Tod Ave (Bare Root Landscaping) for an unwanted subject along with Officer Metz. Just as I was arriving on scene I observed a Black Dodge pick-up heading towards St. Rt. 45 from the private drive of the business. I initially stopped to make a left hand turn into the driveway but due to northbound traffic had to come to a stop and had to wait. When I was waiting to turn into the driveway this black truck stopped short (about 10/15) feet of the roadway. I ended up continuing south on Rt. 45 to turn around while I was waiting on addtional information from dispatch on the truck. I turned around in a driveway access south of Bare Root Landscaping and observed this black truck start to back up slowly still in the driveway of Bare Root Landscaping. I was now northbound on Rt. 45 slowly approaching the driveway to Bare Root Landscaping and I recall Officer Metz asking dispatch about a warrant entry from Liberty P.D. and something about this truck "ramming a cruiser" from the Liberty incident. Just prior to pulling into the driveway I activated my vehicle's emergency lighting and at this time he was driving towards me slowly. He stopped short of my unit and as I was stepping out I could see him cut the truck wheels and he drove through part of a yard around me to get out onto Rt. 45.

**To note:** I could see the driver was a white male subject with a medium/large size dog in the passenger side of the truck. It was difficult to get a good look at the driver as this happend very fast and the truck had a medium dark tint to the side windows. I was aware at this time that the registered owner of this truck was involved in an incident in Liberty Township and there were also warrants out of Lake County. The registered owner of this pick-up truck was Fred Henry Wild III.

I notified dispatch he was taking off and I could see Officer Metz just south of Hallock Young Rd. I notified Officer Metz he was just about to pass this truck. Officer Metz pulled behind the black Dodge pick-up attempting to stop him. This truck continued northbound on St. Rt. 45 at which time I still had my emergency lights and siren activated.

behind this pick-up truck at the next road (Chestnut Ridge Rd) and did not continue down the tracks and decided to get ahead of him at the next intersection. As we got ahead to the next intersection this particular street (Merwin Chase Rd) actually put us above the railroad lines on an overpass. As I stopped on the overpass I could see the pick-up truck a few hundred yards south of our location and it was stopped off to the side with the driver side door open. After obtaining a better visual from the overpass I could not see anyone around however, it still was not clear if someone was inside the pick-up truck.

At this time several units from Brookfield, Vienna, Trumbull County Sheriffs Office, and the Ohio State Highway Patrol were arriving at our location. After a quick brief to these units a perimeter began to be set up. Some Officers began to walk on the east and west side of the tracks from above to get a better visual and attempting to locate the subject from the pick-up truck. Also, Deputy Jarrett from Trumbull County S.O. arrived with his K-9 partner. It was determined the area that would have to be used to get down to the railroad tracks was too steep and dangerous and we would have to get further south to the next railroad crossing intersection to make our way back to the pick-up truck. A couple officers stayed up on the overpass while most of us went around. I went with T.C.S.O. Deputy Jarrett and Timko proceeding to start walking towards the pick-up while Officer Metz and other officers had already gone down the railroad tracks.

Once we all were together, T.C.S.O. Deputy Jarrett along with his K-9 began to attempt and track the driver of this pick-up truck. Also, the Ohio State Highway Patrol had their aviation unit above us attempting to locate this individual.

**To note:** I noticed a temporary Ohio registration the the rear window of the pick-up truck (Ohio Temporary: P630794) which expired October 28th, 2022. I also took a couple photographs of the truck

After walking these railroad tracks and checking several locations within this wooded area we were unsuccessful in locating the driver.

After this we began to make our way back to our vehicles and cleared from the railroad tracks. I spoke with Detective Aaron Kasiewicz from Brookfield. It was determined at this time to have Brookfield tow this vehicle from its current location on the tracks.

After making my way back to my vehicle I continued to check the surrounding area streets for this subject. Shortly after, the decision was made to clear the area as Brookfield Police Department and their surrounding departments were aware of the situation and to be on the lookout for this subject believed to be Fred H. Wild III.

After returning to the station I contacted Ian Poverbs (owner of Bare Root Landscaping) for further information. PROVERBS told me that WILD has worked for him on and off for about 4-5 years now. PROVERBS stated that WILD just came back into the area a couple weeks ago. When asked where WILD has been PROVERBS stated that around November 2022 WILD finished up working for him and said he was moving in with his girlfriend in the Painesville/Mentor Ohio area. PROVERBS told me he knew the girlfriend's name to be Katie. Upon WILD just showing up at Bare Root, PROVERBS advised they were doing some remodeling work inside the house on the property so he put WILD to work. PROVERBS said that prior to WILD moving in with his girlfriend he allowed WILD to put his camper on another piece of property he owns in North Jackson not to far from the business. PROVERBS said WILD had been mostly staying at his camper and initially was doing ok with working at the house.

PROVERBS advised it was about a week ago he believed WILD to be drinking again and not acting right to the point he told WILD a few days ago things were not working out and he had to go. PROVERBS told me he got a text from WILD late Sunday evening but he did not see it until today that WILD said he was inside the shop crashing out on the couch. PROVERBS said when he noticed the text around 8:30am on today's date he looked outside and observed PROVERBS Dodge pick-up truck.

PROVERBS found WILD sleeping on the couch and woke him up telling him he had to go. PROVERBS advised he had a busy day today and was in and out a couple more times with WILD still being there. PROVERBS said around 2:00pm he needed to leave with his girlfriend and told WILD again to leave as he was going to call the police. PROVERBS stated that WILD advised he had no gas in his truck to go anywhere so PROVERBS told me he gave him a gas can with a few gallons of gas and told WILD to put this in his tank and leave. PROVERBS said he had his girlfriend contact our agency as they were pulling out about getting WILD off the property. PROVERBS said he believed WILD had warrants for his arrest because WILD had told him so on another occassion.

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I asked PROVERBS if WILD had used the gas and he advised that he did because the gas can is now empty.

I asked PROVERBS if he knew where WILD had been staying if not in the camper the last few days and he told me that WILD told him he had a friend named Brian who lets him stay in a "deer hunting cabin" on his property. I asked if he knew a last name on "Brian" or where he lived to which PROVERBS replied he did not know a last name but WILD stated it was in either Vienna or Brookfield. PROVERBS provided me with a contact phone number for Masen (unknown last name) who is the son of WILD. PROVERB said Masen used to work for him in the past and he has recently spoken with him about his dad since he came back into town. PROVERBS suggested I contact Masen who may have additional information on locating WILD. PROVERBS gave me a phone number of 330-301-5868 for Masen.

I contacted MASEN and spoke to him for some time. MASEN advised he lives with his grandmother on Keefer Road in Liberty. MASEN told me there was a situation the other night where his dad showed up and he really did not want him there. MASEN advised that they contacted the police to have his dad (WILD) removed and believed him to have a warrant for his arrest. MASEN advised me that his dad has done this type of stuff for years and does well for a while and then goes off the deep end. MASEN told me he did not want to see his father get hurt or hurt anyone else.

I asked MASEN what kind of dog his dad would have had in the truck to which he told me its a german short haired pointer. MASEN said the dog is a very well trained and loyal dog to his dad and would stay right by his side . I next asked MASEN if he knew any friends of his father who is named "Brian" to which he replied he believed that to be the guy whose house he used to go fishing at. MASEN said he has a really big pond behind his house. MASEN asked me to hold on and he was going to ask his grandma if she knew. MASEN came back onto the phone and advised they do not know "Brian's" last name but that he lived on State Rt 7 and he is some kind of "animal trapper". MASEN offered to drive there and get me an address but I told him that was not necessary at this time.

At this time it is unknown where WILD may have gone and additional investigation will be needed to locate his whereabouts.

Captain Bordonaro and I were dispatched to Bare Root Landscaping located at 8447 Tod Ave. in the Village of Lordstown. The owner of the business, Ian Proverbs, also lives at that address with his girlfriend Kelly Stanke. I contacted Proverbs by telephone in route to the call to get more information. Proverbs stated the person he wanted removed was a former employee named Fred Wild. He stated Wild was at his business and wanted him removed. Proverbs was not at the location when I spoke with him, he was bringing his son to a doctor's appointment. Proverbs stated Wild was recently involved in a vehicle pursuit with the Liberty Township Police Department. Proverbs stated in that pursuit, Wild rammed the police patrol cars. I asked what type of vehicle Wild drove. Proverbs stated it was a black Dodge pickup with orange spray painted stripes.

**1412 hrs.**

Captain Bordonaro arrived. I was on Tod Ave. just north of the address. Captain Bordonaro stated over the radio that the subject was in a black pickup attempting to leave.

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driver of the vehicle. The Ohio State Patrol also had an airplane respond to the area. We were unable to locate the driver. The search was called off at 1651 hrs.

Captain Bordonaro was behind me the entire pursuit. Sgt. Demyan was behind Captain Bordonaro for the majority of the pursuit.

The pursuit covered approximately 38 miles. The top speed of the pursuit was 110 mph.

Deputy Lyden from the Lordstown Police Department obtained a written statement from an employee at Bare Root Landscaping, Roman Baker. Baker stated he worked with Wild the day of this incident from 1030 hrs. to approximately 1330 hrs. Baker did not see Wild leave.

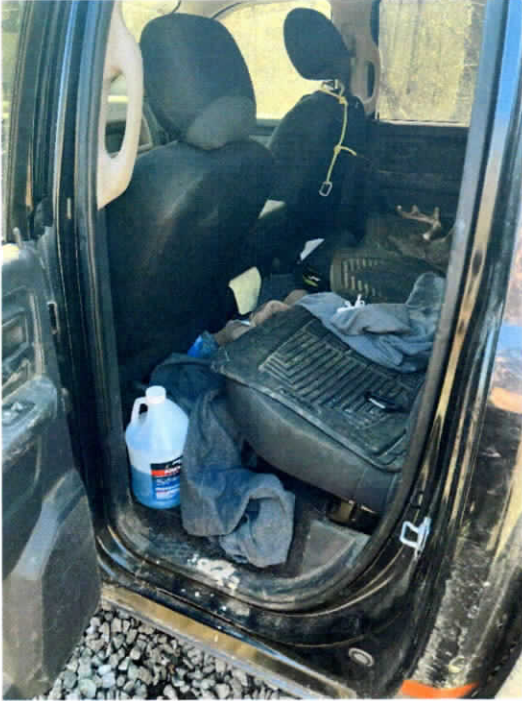

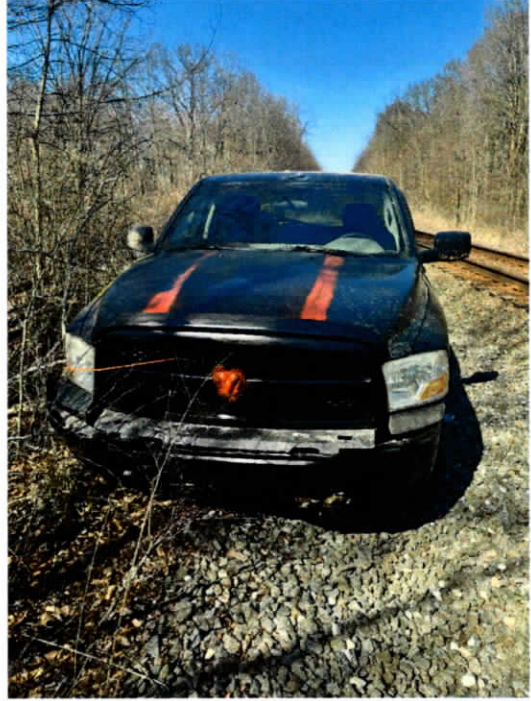

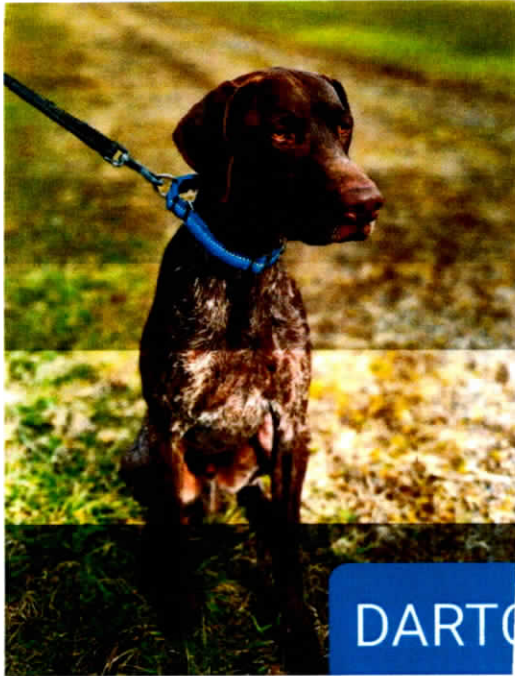

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At approximately 2:00am I was notified by Deputy Drewek that he was in Brookfield and was called for assistance to help locate WILD. Deputy Drewek told me that he was one of several officers from various jurisdictions who went to 1433 St. Rt.7 on a tip that WILD was in a cabin back in the woods in which he possessed a stolen truck. Deputy Drewek stated that WILD tried to escape in the truck and attempted to run them over. Deputy Drewek said at this time shots were fired and the subject in the truck (believed to be WILD) is now deceased. Deputy Drewek told me he did not fire this weapon.

After speaking with Deputy Drewek I contacted Chief Faustino with Brookfield Police Department who advised that he had just arrived on scene and was calling for B.C.I.&I. and the Trumbull County Homicide Task Force. I next contacted Chief Milhoan and briefed him on the situation and advised him I would be enroute to the scene in Brookfield. I met briefly with Officer Drewek who at this point was assisting with traffic at the driveway access that went back to the scene. I met with Trumbull County Sheriff Monroe, S/A Chuck Moran with B.C.I and other law enforcement officials. It was determined to take all officers that were on scene at the time of the incident back to Brookfield Township Police Department. I went back to Officer Drewek and advised him he needed to go to Brookfield Township P.D. I learned that most of the other officers involved in this incident were already taken to Brookfield Township P.D.

After arriving at Brookfield Township Police Department, at some point Officer Drewek gave a statement to S/A Moran who also did a visual inspection of Officer Dreweks firearm and ammunition to account for what he was carrying. I also spoke with S/A Moran and gave him some additional information about our earlier pursuit we had with WILD (See Report # 23-00131) I advised S/A Moran I would finish our investigation into the pursuit with WILD and also obtain the documentation and other items from Liberty Police Department to assist him with his investigation on the day(s) leading up to tonights incident with WILD.

It should also be noted that while at Brookfield Township P.D. I got a phone call from Major Villanueva with T.C.S.O. Maj. Villanueva advised he has a dog (german short hair) that came out of the woods by the crime scene and is on his way to Brookfield P.D. to get the dog away from the scene. Once Maj. Villanueva arrived with the dog Healthy Hearts and Paws was contacted to assist with keeping this dog for the time being. While waiting on them to arrive it was learned that on the dogs collar was the name of Katie Wheeler with a phone number of [REDACTED] I believe this to be the girlfriend of WILD as I was advised earlier in the day that WILD had a girlfriend in the Mentor/Painesville area named Katie. I also believe this to be the dog in the vehicle with WILD

On the above date and time, this Department received a call from TC911 to assist Brookfield PD with locating a known suspect and serving a warrant. The suspect was identified as Fred H. Wild III DOB: 01/12/1973. The address location known for this suspect was 1433 SR7 NE, Brookfield, Ohio 44403 in a cabin deep into the woods. The prior meeting location of all responding Officers was identified as just south of the above location in the parking lot area of "Intense Fabrication & Design Inc", 1266 SR7 NE, Brookfield, Ohio 44403.

Deputy Drewek did take the call and met up with responding Officers from multiple Law Enforcement jurisdictions at the above location. Jurisdictions included were Brookfield, Vienna, Hubbard Twp, Liberty, TCSO and OSHP. Sgt [REDACTED] of Brookfield PD did provide responding Officers a briefing of the suspect, Wild III, and his location in a cabin approximately 500 yards off the roadway in a wooded area. This cabin was described as 12 foot by 12 foot, one door and windows around the sides. Wild III has recently stolen a truck with a snow plow attached, known to possibly be armed with a musket rifle and possibly have a dog.

Deputy Drewek did provide guide assistance in the darkness with a thermal imaging device to a team of 5 to 8 Officers with handguns and rifles. While the team was walking West down a lane towards the wooded area, we started to approach a large garage building to our South. This building had an unexpected sensor motion light (North side of building) that turned on and briefly lighted our path before the wooded area.

Officers could first observe loud music and a dim lit light coming from the direction of the cabin area, while continuing to walk down a lane into the wooded area. Officers continued to this cabin making their initial approach from the South and East sides to their respective positions with the intentions to first surround and secure the cabin. The loud music was obviously coming from inside the stolen truck. The dim lit light was coming from inside the cabin and now visible from an open window on the South side of the cabin. This stolen truck was quickly checked by an Officer for no person(s) inside. This truck was parked extremely close to the cabin and was parked facing East, the plow was already in a raised position approximately 6 to 8 inches off the ground. One unknown Officer near me (South side) noticed and advised me that he could see the male subject sitting in a chair, facing North, inside the cabin next to an open window. I started to walk toward the back of the cabin as it appeared to have a porch area, possibly locating other subject(s). All of a sudden, something must have startled the male subject seated near the window. The male subject immediately stood

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up and faced the open window, now recognized as Wild III. Wild III apparently now sees people directly outside this window near the truck. Wild III acted very quickly, without hesitation and within seconds, jumps through this open cabin window and directly into the adjacent open driver side window of the stolen truck. Officers immediately turned flashlights on at the suspect and repeatedly yelled "Police, Police stop your under arrest!!". Wild III positioned himself in the driver's seat, unknown if the engine was already running. Wild III then proceeded to drive in a forward very aggressive manner. The engine was roaring loud and right rear tire peeling up dirt/debris and knocking over small trees toward Officers. There was an unknown amount of immediate gun fire and the truck came to a rest after approximately 20 feet. I did not fire my duty weapon as it was still holstered, while using my thermal device clearing the back side of the cabin. An Officer yelled, "He is not moving!" Wild III was then observed to be half slumped off to his right side, open wound to the back top right side of his head and lifeless. An Officer tried opening the passenger door of the truck but it was secure. This same Officer then used an expandable baton and broke through the window, unlocked to open the door, put the transmission into park and turned the ignition off thus, silenced the loud music.

Officers secured the scene, took accountability and notified respective supervision and medical personnel. Tpr. Brown quickly arrived near the cabin in his patrol car and secured all weapons of Officers that had fired shots. Those Officers then remained near the scene for further instructions. Myself and another Officer that did not fire a shot were then requested to provide further area security for investigators of local Police agencies, TCSO, OHSP and BCI&I.

My duty position and an Officer from Brookfield PD were assigned a post at the end of this driveway at SR7 for access of the above named agencies. I then contacted Captain Bordonaro to advise of the eminent situation and he arrived on scene as well. I remained at this post until properly relieved. I then was instructed and traveled to Brookfield PD for screening and interview by BCI&I.

While I was waiting in the lobby at Brookfield PD, an Officer brought in a skinny medium size brown friendly type bird dog. This dog was said to have came out of the wooded area near the cabin. This Dog had a collar and a tag with an owner Name & phone number known to local Officers, belonging to the girlfriend of the deceased suspect. Chief Faustino advised that this dog was needed to be secure in an area for a period of time. Chief suggested to contact Jason Cooke of "Healthy Hearts and Paws Project", as this business is closely located in Brookfield. I made phone contact with Jason. Jason stated that he is

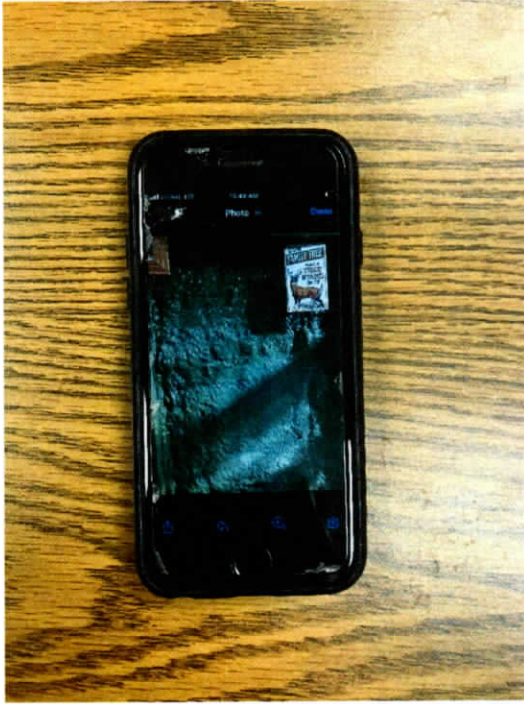

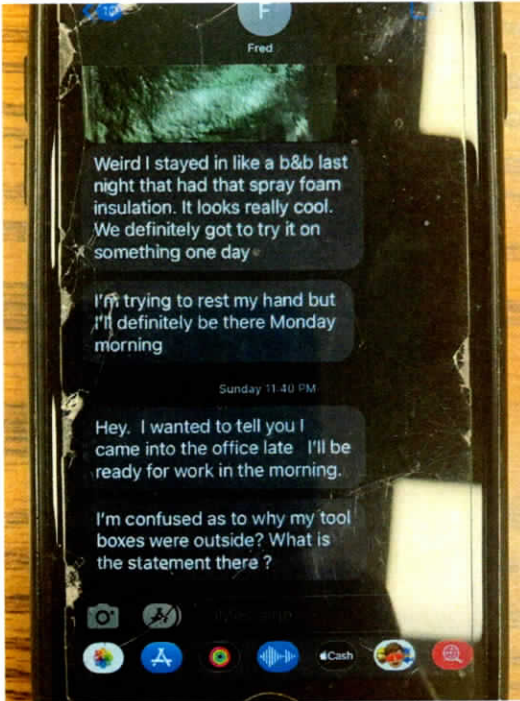

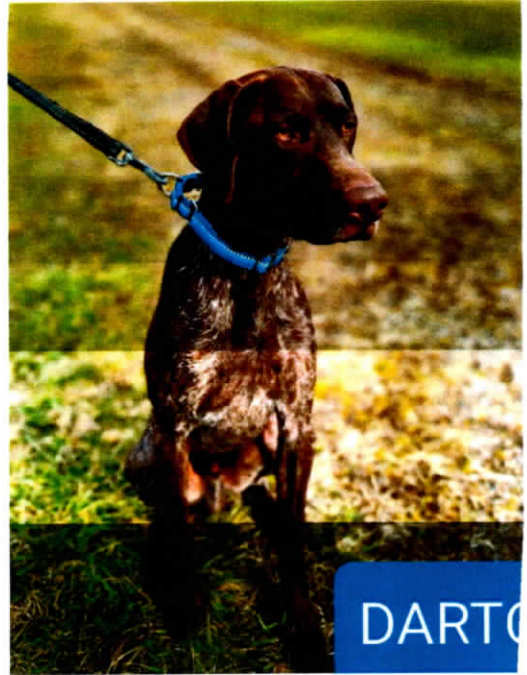

On Saturday, 02/04/2023, at approximately 0023hours Officers McCloud and Parkomaki were advised Eastlake PD Sgt. Ward was currently following a possible impaired driver, operating a black 2010 Dodge Ram, OH. Reg. HZS1483, which was exiting SR44 at W. Jackson St.

Sgt. Ward asked if PPD wanted him to conduct a traffic stop with the vehicle as mutual assistance until PPD arrived, which was authorized. At this time the vehicle was traveling around the roundabout on Brookstone Blvd. then began traveling n/b on Brookstone Blvd. to the north of the roundabout. As Sgt. Ward activated his overhead lights the vehicle drove over a curb on the east side of the roadway and fled onto a dirt road northeast of Brookstone Blvd., north east of the roundabout on Brookstone Blvd.

Upon Officer McCloud's arrival, Officer located Sgt. Ward still parked on the paved road north of the roundabout, and could see headlights from the vehicle northeast of the location. Officer McCloud also observed the front of the vehicle appeared to be lower than the rear lights on the vehicle, as the headlights were lower than the rear red lights, indicating the vehicle had possibly drove into a ditch.

Officer McCloud and Sgt. Ward drove their patrol vehicle's to the suspect vehicle location where it was found the front of the vehicle was in fact in a small ditch, and the vehicle was currently unoccupied. As Officer McCloud approached the vehicle, it was found the vehicle was unlocked, the lights were still on and there was an open 24oz Twisted Tea can in a cup holder under the radio, which was approximately a quarter way full and was cool to the touch.

Sgt. Ward asked if Painesville PD wished for him to deploy his K9 to conduct a track of the driver of the vehicle, which was authorized by Sgt. Miller. Sgt. Ward deployed his K9, which began to run in a northwesterly direction along a dirt road from the location of the truck. The K9 traveled for approximately 800feet, along the dirt road then the K9 then turned and began traveling in a southwesterly direction from the dirt road into a patch of wooded area. Moments later Officers began hearing a dog barking, which sounded close to officers location, and was in the direction the K9 was traveling.

Approximately 50feet into the wooded area, Officer McCloud and Sgt. Ward observed a w/m wearing a grey jacket with an orange hooded sweatshirt underneath stand up and begin running away from officers in a southwesterly direction. Officers began giving the male loud verbal commands to stop, which the male did not comply with. A foot pursuit ensued where during Officer McCloud observed the male to look back at officers several times while running. The male ran for approximately 400feet before he was caught by Sgt. Ward and tackled to the ground. The male was taken in custody by Officer McCloud, by being handcuffed to the rear, with proper gaps ensured and double locked. Officer McCloud removed the male's wallet from his rear right pocket and located his ID card, where he was identified as 50yoa Fred H. Wild III, who was also the registered owner of the Dodge which fled from Sgt. Ward.

A search of Fred's person, incident to arrest, found him to be in possession of a set of keys one being marked for a Dodge vehicle. The vehicle key was later tried in the ignition of the Dodge, which was found to start the Dodge. Fred also had a German Shorthaired Pointer dog with him, which was later secured in Unit 739 and was transported to the Lake County Dog Warden by Officer Parkomaki.

As Officer McCloud and Sgt. Ward were walking Fred to their patrol cars, Officer McCloud asked him what he was doing back in the area and he advised he was "Trapping coyotes" and advised he went to the location to do so every night. While speaking with Fred, Officer McCloud detected a strong odor of alcoholic beverages coming from his breath, his eyes were bloodshot and glossy, he had a slur to his speech and he was unsteady on his feet; nearly falling several times while walking and Officer McCloud caught him. Fred initially began stating he did not know why Officers were arresting him and denied having operated the vehicle.

Upon returning to the patrol vehicle's Officer McCloud placed Fred in the rear of Unit 723, where he was read a Miranda Rights Card and when asked, he advised he understood his rights. Fred agreed to speak with officer about the incident, where stated he had been coming to the location for weeks to trap coyotes. Officer McCloud asked Fred where he was coming from, when he was coming to the location, and relayed Sgt. Ward's observations to Fred, and Fred advised he was coming from "My girlfriend's house." Officer McCloud asked Fred how much alcohol he had consumed and he advised he had not been drinking. Based on observations, Fred was asked if he would submit to SFSTs, which he agreed to. Officer McCloud observed Fred was wearing glasses, and was asked if he had any other medical

problems with his eyes and he advised, "No." Fred was asked if he had any medical disabilities which prohibited him from walking or balancing properly, where he advised, "No." The HGN was performed on the side of Unit 723, and the Walk and Turn and One Leg Stand were conducting in front of Unit 723.

The following are observations made by Officer McCloud during the SFSTs:

## HGN

During the HGN, Fred was kept handcuffed, as Sgt. Ward was attending to his K9, and there was not another officer to standby. Fred was advised to stand with his feet together, and Officer McCloud held a red sharpie marker approximately 11-15" from his face, where Fred was asked if he could see the tip of the marker clearly and he advised, "Yes". Fred was advised to follow the tip of the stimulus with his eyes and eyes only and not to move his head, which he advised he understood.

Officer McCloud first checked Fred's pupil size and for resting nystagmus. Officer McCloud observed Fred's pupils to be similar in size and he did show signs of resting nystagmus. Officer McCloud then checked Fred's eyes for equal tracking and found his eyes to track the stimulus equally. During the Lack of Smooth Pursuit, Fred displayed nystagmus in both eyes. During the Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation, Fred displayed nystagmus in both eyes. During the Onset of Nystagmus Prior to 45degrees, Fred displayed immediate nystagmus in both eyes. Fred was then checked for Vertical Nystagmus, which he displayed in each eyes. It should be noted that indications of Vertical Nystagmus indicates it is a high dose for that individual person.

During the HGN, Fred displayed 6 indicators of impairment.

## Walk and Turn

The Walk and Turn was conducted in front of Unit 723. The ground was gravel surface that was packed down and was mostly flat. The area that was used for the test was free of large debris which would have impeded Fred's ability to walk or balance properly. It should be noted that Officer McCloud was able to explain and demonstrate the test without losing his balance on the surface.

At this time Fred was removed from the handcuffs so he could complete the test. Fred was advised to stand with his right foot in front of his left, touching heel-to-toe, with his arms flat at his sides. Fred was unable to maintain the starting position and stepped out of the starting position one time. Fred was advised to maintain the position and not to start until told to do so, which he advised he understood. Officer McCloud explained and demonstrated the test, where when asked if he understood the instructions Fred confirmed he understood.

When told to begin, Fred began taking steps that were not heel-to-toe, his steps were not in a straight line and his arms were 6" or more off his sides during the entirety of the test. Fred turned in an incorrect manner; as he turned in one swift motion on one foot instead of with a series of small steps as instructed, and proceeded to walk again not heel-to-toe, using his arms for balance and not in a straight line.

During the Walk and Turn, Fred displayed 5 indicators of impairment.

## One Leg Stand

Fred was instructed into the starting position, by standing with his feet together and with his hands flat at his sides. Fred was advised to stay in the starting position until told to do so, which he advised he understood. Officer McCloud explained and demonstrated the test to Fred, which he advised he understood when asked.

When told to begin, Fred lifted his left leg for approximately 4 seconds before nearly falling and putting his foot down. Fred then lifted his left leg again, and held the position for approximately 2 seconds before starting to fall backwards and putting his foot down. Fred then stood still momentarily then hunched over for the remainder of the test. During the time Fred had his leg lifted he used his arms for balance, by lifting them more than 6" off his sides and would sway back and forth.

During the One Leg Stand, Fred displayed 3 indicators of impairment.

Fred was transported to the LCSO Jail where he is held on no bond for OVI (ORC 4511.19 A1a)(F3), OVI Refusal (ORC 4511.19 A2)(M1), Failure to Comply (ORC 2921.331)(M1), Obstructing Official Business (ORC 2921.31)(M2), and Open Container in a M.V. (ORC 4301.62)(MM). Fred will be held until his PMC arraignment on 02/06/2023 at 1300hours.

The vehicle was photographed by Officer McCloud, prior to be removed from the scene by Bob's Towing, and Fred's dog was transported to the Dog Warden for safekeeping. All photos are attached to this report. The license plate was also seized and is attached to this report. Due to the previous convictions of OVI, Wild's vehicle is subject to forfeiture.

The dash cam for Unit 723 was later burned to a DVD, which was logged, tagged and entered into evidence by Officer McCloud. The dispatch tapes were also obtained by Officer McCloud, where they were burned to a DVD, then logged, tagged and entered into evidence. Copies of both are attached to this report.

Officer McCloud printed out a screenshot of Google Maps, with the satellite filter, and mapped the path the K9 took from the vehicle. Officer McCloud also marked the point where the vehicle was located, a dotted path the K9 took, where Fred was first observed and where he was taken into custody. The print out is attached to this report.

Additionally, based on Fred's statement of being at the location to trap coyotes, and being the property is owned by the City of Mentor, Officer McCloud contacted the ODNR and spoke with Officer Frank, who was relayed the details of the call. Officer Frank advised he was familiar with Fred and had cited him several times for hunting and trapping violations in the past. Officer Frank obtained information about the case and advised he would send the information to an Officer in Lake County for further investigation.

Sgt. Ward emailed a copy of his report, which is attached to this report. Officer McCloud was also advised Sgt. Ward does not have a dash camera in his patrol unit.

On 2/28/23 at 2116hrs Ptl. Fekete, Ptl. Magnuson, and I were dispatched to Menards (9600 Diamond Centre Dr) for a vandalism that just occurred.

While en route dispatch advised an older white male in a brown jacket with an orange hoodie had thrown a board at the rear loading area roll up door breaking glass. He was attempting to leave in a red fiat through the lumber yard exit.

Upon arrival I learned the following:

Joseph Lewis (Menards Manager) had finished loading purchased wood into the red fiat with other employees. Once inside the building they heard a loud noise coming from the area of the southeast roll up door where the fiat was parked near. Lewis observed the previously mentioned male, later identified as Fred Wild, throwing wood that had been in the Fiat at the roll up door. Wild began cussing at Lewis when he asked him not to throw the wood at the building. Wild then picked up a wood board and forcefully threw it threw one of the glass windows in the door breaking it. I observed a window to the roll up door to be broken. Lewis completed a written statement.

I reviewed security camera footage with Lewis. The security camera is mounted above the roll up door. I saw the red Fiat parked facing west with Menards employees loading the vehicle next to the driver, Katlin Snyder. The roll up door was located to the north of the Fiat. While they are loading I could see Wild in the front passenger seat with his head down appearing to be up against the passenger side window or dashboard. Once the employees leave the area Wild exits the vehicle and begins throwing wood from the rear of the car onto the ground. He then takes wood from the ground and throws it at the roll up door. One board he appears to forcefully jab at the door. The camera angle does not show the impact or the breaking of the glass. Menards will contact MPD when a copy of the security camera footage is available. Lewis advised the estimated cost to repair the door at over six hundred dollars.

I read Wild his Miranda Rights, which he stated he understood, and he agreed to continue speaking to me in regards to this incident. Wild advised he was unsatisfied with how the Fiat was loaded by Menards employees and was throwing the wood out of frustration. He stated he did not intend to break the glass on the door. Wild was handcuffed, searched with negative results, and placed in the rear of my patrol car (543).

He was transported to MPD Jail and charged with the following:

- Vandalism (ORC 2909.05b1b F5) -For knowingly causing physical harm to property that is necessary in order for its owner to engage in the owner's business.

Due to the felony charge no bond was given. He has no prior convictions of vandalism on his CCH.

I asked him what the problem was and if he could not throw the lumber at the door so it didn't get broken. He was very irate and cursing at us and wouldn't tell us the problem. I closed the door and then he picked up one of the boards and forced it thru the garage door window breaking it and sending glass towards us. I then notified my closing acting general manager the situation and to call the police and gave a description of guest and vehicle.
