Narrative:

On Thursday, November 8, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) obtained and reviewed background information on Ricco Acevedo (Acevedo), the subject involved in the officer-involved critical incident at 4312 Helena Avenue, Youngstown, Mahoning County, Ohio. The information included: criminal history records, court records (if applicable), and open/closed source database inquiries. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit.

SA Tingley reviewed the documentation and noted the following:

Active Arrest Warrant

Acevedo had an active arrest warrant for his arrest from the Warren Municipal Court for Failure to Appear for a misdemeanor Theft charge.

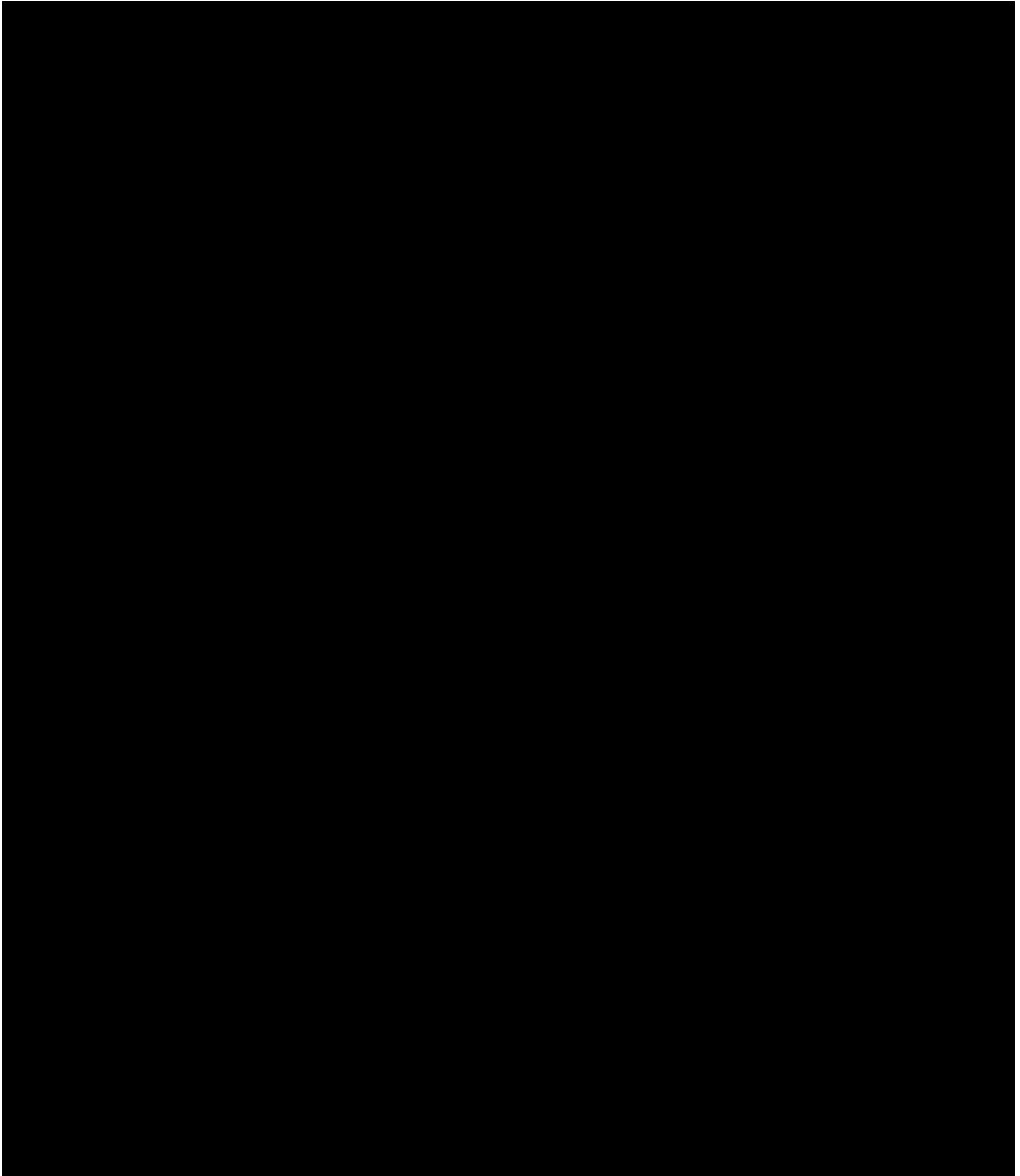
Prior Police Encounters
