**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, July 08, 2025, at 1355 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Administrative Professional (AP) Betsy Turney (Turney) submitted items to the BCI laboratory for analysis.

The following seven items were submitted:

6. (1) Envelope containing projectile fragments removed from Patrick Kerr during autopsy

The analysis requested was to determine if the rifle collected from [REDACTED] was capable of firing the recovered fragments recovered from Patrick Kerr during autopsy. Operability testing was requested for both submitted firearms, and NIBIN entries were requested for the Glock 45. The 9mm fired cartridge casing was submitted to determine if the Glock 45 handgun had fired or was capable of firing the round. DNA
