You have submitted for my examination, under authority of section 4785-175 of the General Code, a written petition bearing over one hundred names proposing to amend the Constitution of Ohio by adding Section 13 to Article XII; by adding to Article XVIII Section 15; and amending Section 2 of Article 12, together with summaries of the same.

Upon examination of the text of said proposed constitutional amendments and the summaries thereof, I am of the opinion that said summaries are not fair and truthful statements of the proposed constitutional amendments, and for such reason I am unable to make the certification as requested by you.
