Narrative:

On Tuesday, June 24, 2025, at approximately 1511 hours, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by Chief Scott Mielke of the Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) to conduct an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding an officer-involved shooting which occurred at the intersection of Tiedeman Road and the I-480 West exit/entrance ramp in Brooklyn, Ohio 44144, Cuyahoga County. BCI Special Agent (SA) Allison Fletcher (Fletcher) responded to assist and arrived at 1600 hours. Also responding from the BCI Force Investigations Unit (FIU) was SA Joseph Goudy, SA John Tingley, and SA Joseph Lamping. SA Eric Lehnhart responded from BCI Special Investigations Unit. Additionally, the BCI Crime Scene Unit (CSU) was requested to process the scene by documenting and collecting pertinent evidence. BCI CSU Agents included Laurna McClintock and Chad Dorner.

The shooting incident involved a subject, Patrick Kerr, and a member of the Strongsville Police Department (SPD) and Southwest Enforcement Bureau (SWAT team), [REDACTED]. The incident resulted in the death of Patrick Kerr.
