**Narrative:**

On July 11, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) requested the following items related to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] from Geauga County Sheriff's Office Lieutenant Jim Jonovich (Lieutenant Jonovich):

- OPOTA Certification records and/or any other training records
- Firearm qualification records
- Personnel Files (including any disciplinary or internal affairs records for previous incidents) but excluding copies of any internal affairs investigation or Garrity Statements relative to the current incident under investigation.
