APPROVAL—GRANTS OF EASEMENT, NOS. 1719 AND 1720. STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, TRACT OF LAND IN RICHLAND AND RUSH-CREEK TOWNSHIPS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS AND TO IMPROVE THE WATERS OR WATER COURSES PASSING THROUGH AND OVER SAID LANDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, No. 1719 and 1720, executed to the State of Ohio by Rushville Union School Board and Grace McCafferty, et al. respectively, conveying to the State of Ohio for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in Richland and Rushcreek Townships, Fairfield County, Ohio.

By the above grants, there are conveyed to the State of Ohio certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through and over said lands.
