**Narrative:**

On Thursday, December 19, 2024, at 1316 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb) and SA Aja Chung (SA Chung) interviewed Molly Wainer (Wainer), relative to the officer-involved critical incident which took place on Thursday, December 19, 2024. The interview took place at her place of employment, Doyle HCM, 735 Taylor Road, Gahanna, OH. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information about the incident known or observed by this individual.

Wainer stated that she works at Doyle HCM as payroll/IT. Wainer said that she was working on the first floor when Carey Williams (Williams) yelled to stay away from the windows. She then ran out of her office and went to the small kitchen. Williams then told her that something was going on. Wainer then went into Williams' office and saw multiple police cruisers with their emergency lights activated.

Wainer only saw the subject as he was walking northbound across Taylor Road. He was a heavier set, white male with a black sleeveless shirt. She said it looked like he had something in his right hand, but she couldn't see distance well and didn't have on her glasses.

Wainer said she didn't hear anything until the gunshots occurred. She thinks she heard 12-15 gunshots. There was one round of gunshots, a couple of seconds and then additional gunshots.

SA Holcomb asked Wainer if she believed that the officers were well represented as law enforcement officers. She replied with, "Oh yeah." She believes she saw four (4) officers before the shooting occurred. She couldn't tell if any officers had their firearms drawn.

Wainer stated that she did not take any photos or videos of the incident.

The interview concluded at approximately 1320 hours.
