## Narrative:

On Thursday, January 16, 2025, the Alliance Police Department (APD) requested Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 350 South Arch Avenue, Alliance, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (SA Valente) attended the post-mortem examination of the subject, Mason French (French). The examination was conducted on January 17, 2025 at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office in Cleveland, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Kara Gawelek.

The following observations were made during the course of the autopsy:

French was assigned

Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Case OU-2025-00023.

SA Valente requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports once available.

Any pieces of possible evidence removed or collected from French's person were not immediately available for release at the time of the conclusion of the autopsy.
