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EASEMENT—TO STATE BY H. B. CHENOWETH, LAND, PLEASANT TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, AND DARBY TOWNSHIP, PICKAWAY COUNTY, USE, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain grant of easement, No. 2533, executed to the State of Ohio by H. B. Chenoweth, conveying to the State of Ohio for the purposes therein stated, a certain tract of land in Pleasant Township, Franklin County, Ohio and Darby Township, Pickaway County, Ohio.

By the above grant there is conveyed to the State of Ohio, certain land described therein, for the sole purpose of using said land for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through the over said land.
