PETITION, TO AMEND CONSTITUTION OF OHIO — ADD TO ARTICLE XV, SECTION II, MONTHLY PENSION, SINGLE PERSONS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OVER, NEEDY, PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, UNABLE TO PURSUE GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT.

Dear Sir:

You have submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names, containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under Section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution of the State of Ohio by adding Section II to Article XV relative to a monthly pension for single persons eighteen years of age or over who are needy and physically handicapped and unable to pursue gainful employment. (Summary — see File Attorney General.)

I am of the opinion that the attached summary is a fair and truthful statement of the proposed constitutional amendment and accordingly submit for uses provided by law the following certification:
