Narrative:

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, at approximately 0815 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) was sent to 681 Fourth Street Southwest, Warren, Ohio 44483. SA Lamping was serving as a member of the North Major Case Response Team, and the team had been dispatched to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred in the area of the listed address.

Upon arrival, SA Lamping met with command staff members of the Warren Police Department (WPD), Lieutenant Bryan Holmes (Lt. Holmes) and Sergeant Mark Krempasky (Sgt. Krempasky), as well as a command staff member from the Trumbull County Sheriff's Office (TCSO), Captain John Elberty (Capt. Elberty). SA Lamping was informed that the involved subject, Brad Bailey (Bailey), had been involved in a domestic at his residence earlier in the morning. Bailey had left the scene, and officers were on the lookout for his vehicle. Somewhere outside of Warren, Bailey was located, and an officer attempted to stop his vehicle. When Bailey failed to stop, a pursuit ensued involving TCSO deputies and Champion Police Officers. The pursuit continued into Warren, where a WPD officer utilized spike strips to terminate the pursuit on Fifth Street SW. When Bailey's vehicle became immobilized, he exited and ran North towards Fourth Street SW. While in the area of 681 Fourth Street SW, an OICI occurred, ultimately resulting in the death of Bailey.

Lt. Holmes informed SA Lamping that the involved and witness officers from WPD had already been transported back to WPD. He also advised that one officer fired his weapon, one deployed his canine partner, which may have bitten Bailey, and one was a witness. Additionally, WPD had collected Bailey's clothing and had it at WPD. SA Darien Spann (SA Spann) went to WPD to complete an introduction to the officers. See SA Spann's report for further information. Lt. Holmes also told SA Lamping that the Champion officers were at their police department. SA Jesse Bynum went to the

Champion Police Department to complete an introduction with those officers. See SA Bynum's report for further information.

SA Lamping spoke with Capt. Elberty who stated that the two involved deputies were at TCSO. He also noted that he had possession of their firearms and spare magazines. SA John Saraya went to TCSO to complete an introduction to the officers while SA Lamping collected the firearms from Capt. Elberty. Capt. Elberty had already rendered the firearms safe. It was noted that all spare magazines were full, and as such were returned to Capt. Elberty. The firearm belonging to [REDACTED] had ten rounds in the magazine and a loose round that was in the chamber. The Glock 22, belonging to [REDACTED], had 12 rounds in the magazine and one in the chamber. SA Lamping photographed the firearms and later stored the photos on Axon Justice as part of Reference Item A Photographs. The firearms were later signed over to SA Spann to be logged into temporary evidence. The evidence receipt was attached to this report where it can be reviewed in its entirety.

SA Lamping provided Lt. Holmes and Capt. Elberty with OICI booklets and showed them the page documenting the records that would be requested.

SA Lamping remained on scene, assisted the crime scene unit, and completed a neighborhood canvas.
