APPROVAL—LEASE TO RESERVOIR LAND AT BUCKEYE LAKE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO—JESSE A. GROVE, NEWARK, OHIO.

HON. L. WOODDELL, *Conservation Commissioner, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR: This is to acknowledge the receipt of your recent communication with which you submit for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to Jesse A. Grove of Newark, Ohio. By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$15.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes the inner slope and waterfront and the outer slope and borrow pits adjacent thereto, that is included in the east half of the east half of Embankment Lot No. 37, west of the west gates at Buckeye Lake, as laid out on the north shore of said lake by the Ohio Canal Commission in 1905 and being part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 23, Town 17, Range 18, Fairfield County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner, acting on behalf of the state of Ohio, and by Jesse A. Grove, the lessee therein named. I further find, upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the provisions of Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with order statutory provisions relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith enclosed.
