Narrative:

On November 12, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel reviewed documents provided by the Hancock County Emergency Medical Services (Hanco EMS) and the Findlay Fire Department (FFD). The records included any reports or documents pertaining to the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that took place at 1105 Bernard Avenue, Findlay, Ohio, on October 28, 2024, involving the Findlay Police Department (FPD) and juvenile Calvin Darapheth (Calvin).

SA Rammel reviewed the documents and noted the following:

The Hanco EMS run report identified Victoria Chaney (Chaney) as the primary Paramedic who attended to Calvin and Ethan Johnson (Johnson) as the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and driver of the ambulance. Additional medical personnel identified included Paramedic Howard Jackson (Jackson).

The initial medical response was taken by the FPD and was identified as a "gunshot wound".

The response location was identified as 930 McManness Avenue, Findlay, Ohio.

The incident type was identified as a "police matter" with "provide basic life support" as the actions taken.
