APPROVAL—GRANT OF EASEMENT No. 1298, TO STATE OF OHIO BY VILLAGE OF HILLSBORO, HIGHLAND COUNTY, OHIO, CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS AND TO IMPROVE THE WATER OR WATER COURSES PASSING THROUGH AND OVER SAID LANDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain grant of easement, No. 1298, executed to the State of Ohio, by the Village of Hillsboro, Highland County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, a certain tract of land in said village.

By the above grant there is conveyed to the State of Ohio certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the water or water courses passing through and over said lands.

Upon examination of the above instrument, I find that the same has been executed and acknowledged by the grantor in the manner provided by law and am accordingly approving the same as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon, all of which are herewith returned.
