after the date of such publication and for ninety days thereafter receive applications for the purchase of such canal lands, and that after the expiration of said period, sales (and leases) of such abandoned canal lands may be made in accordance with the provisions of said act. It does not appear from any recitals or other statements of fact made in the transcript here under consideration, that any advertisement of such notice was made preliminary to the application for the purchase of this particular parcel of land. As to this, I am advised by your office, however, that the required notice was in fact published in the manner provided by law, although, as above noted, no recital of this fact appears in the transcript.

On the considerations above noted, I am hereby approving your proceedings relating to the purchase of the parcel of abandoned Ohio Canal lands above described, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the transcript of said proceedings and upon the duplicate copy thereof.
