APPROVAL, LEASE TO ROOMS IN SECURITY HOME BANK BUILDING, TOLEDO, OHIO, FOR USE OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a lease between I. J. Fulton, Superintendent of Banks, in charge of the liquidation of the Security Home Trust Company, Toledo, Ohio, and yourself, as Director of Public Works for the State of Ohio, by the terms of which lease, rooms 825-827 on the eighth floor of the Security Bank Building, Madison Avenue and Huron Street, Toledo, Ohio, are let for the use of the State Fire Marshal for the period of nineteen months, beginning May 1, 1933, and ending December 31, 1934, at a rental of forty (\$40.00) per month.
