On February 26, 2024, as part of an ongoing officer involved critical incident investigation, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Gill responded to Grant Medical Center to collect personal belongings that had been removed from the involved individual, Colin Jennings (Jennings), following the incident.

CST Gill arrived at Grant Medical Center at approximately 1200 hours and was escorted to the morgue by security personnel. Three bags of items belonging to Jennings were located on the floor inside the secured morgue area. CST Gill collected the bags at approximately 1208 hours and travelled to the BCI Main Office located in London, Ohio, where the items were photographed and packaged. The bags contained one pair of jeans, one pair of blue shorts, one blue t-shirt, one pair of blue sneakers, one pair of socks, and one brown coat with taser leads attached. A yellow stress ball and blue inhaler were located inside the coat pocket. An American flag wallet containing miscellaneous cards with the name Colin Jennings was also located inside the bags. The clothing, stress ball, and inhaler, along with the original hospital packaging, were collected as item 1. The wallet and cards were collected as item 2.

At approximately 1345 hours, all items were submitted to the BCI temporary evidence locker #1 to be submitted to the BCI Major Crimes evidence vault.
