## Narrative:

On Thursday, January 16, 2025, the Alliance Police Department (APD) requested assistance from the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 350 South Arch Avenue, Alliance, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (SA Valente) attended the post-mortem examination of victim, Stacy Pride (Pride). The examination was conducted on January 18, 2025 at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office in Cleveland, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Thomas Gilson.

Note: SA Valente received a phone call from Tamara Wilkes, Forensic Investigator with the Stark County Coroner's Office the previous day, January 17, 2025. During that phone call, Investigator Wilkes informed SA Valente that during an x-ray and external observation of Pride's person conducted by the Stark County Coroner's Office, and, based on this finding, Pride

was being transferred to the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Officer for a full autopsy.

A rifle bullet removed from Pride's right shoulder area was received with her person at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office.

The following observations were made during the autopsy:

Pride was assigned Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Case OU-2025-00025.

SA Valente requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports once available.
