I am further of the opinion that the moneys from the proceeds of said sale, which the court ordered to be paid to The Ohio Savings Bank and Trust Company by the order of December, 1926, should be paid from the general funds of Ottawa County.

Dear Sir:—In Opinion No. 1915, dated March 30, 1928, and addressed to your predecessor in office, Hon. George F. Schlesinger, I approve forms of resolution to be adopted by boards of county commissioners proposing to co-operate with your department. One of the forms covered proposal in counties having less than a three million dollar tax duplicate, in which the co-operation is limited to "widening the paved portion of any state road where the paved portion of any such road is constructed, or reconstructed to a width of eighteen feet." The other form covered the proposal in counties having a tax duplicate in excess of three million dollars, where the co-operation is unrestricted.

In view of certain of the conclusions reached in Opinion No. 2632, dated September 27, 1928, addressed to you, I believe it is advisable to make some slight change of phraseology in the forms and I am accordingly submitting the following which I believe to be more satisfactory than the ones heretofore submitted:

DISAPPROVAL, BONDS OF THE CITY OF XENIA, GREENE COUNTY— \$11,000.00.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, October 17, 1928.

Re: Bonds of the City of Xenia, Greene County, \$11,000.00.

The Industrial Commission of Ohio, Columbus, Ohio.

Gentlemen:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the commission and other officers of the City of Xenia, Greene County, Ohio, relative to the above bonds, which are being issued without a vote of the people, for the purpose of purchasing certain fire apparatus.

The transcript contains a copy of the ordinance to issue bonds, which provides that said bonds shall mature as follows:

"One bond on September 1st in each of the years from 1930 to 1939, both inclusive," etc.

The transcript also contains a copy of the bond sale advertisement, which recites that the bonds will be due and payable as follows:

"One bond on September 1st in each of the years from 1929 to 1938, both inclusive," etc.

The maturities of the bonds as advertised for sale do not correspond with the maturities of the bonds as provided for in the bond ordinance, and I am therefore of the opinion that the sale of the bonds in pursuance of such bond advertisement is illegal.

The transcript is deficient in a number of other respects, but in view of the foregoing I am compelled to advise you not to purchase the above issue of bonds.
