APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASES, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, TERM FIFTEEN YEARS, DESIGNATED LANDS, ANNUAL RENTALS, INDIAN LAKE, OHIO, TO O. C. BOLIN, COLUMBUS, OHIO, \$20.00; LEONARD HELWAGEN, DAYTON, OHIO, \$6.00.

DEAR SIR: You recently submitted for my examination and approval, two reservoir land leases executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to the lessees therein named, by which there were leased and demised to the lessees therein named, parcels of reservoir lands owned by the State at Indian Lake, Ohio.

By the lease executed to O. C. Bolin of Columbus, Ohio, which provides for an annual rental of \$20,00, there is leased and demised to O. C. Bolin permission to occupy and use for lawn, walkway and docklanding purposes only, that portion of the state reservoir property at Indian Lake that lies in front of Lot No. 9, of Waterbury's Allotment (Unrecorded) and being that portion of state land lying between the ordinary water line of Indian Lake and the westerly line of Lot No. 9; said lot having a frontage of eighty (80) feet and being a part of Virginia Military Surveys Nos. 10121, 9946 and 9925, Washington Township, Logan County, Ohio.

By the lease executed to Leonard Helwagen of Dayton, Ohio, which provides for an annual rental of \$6.00, there is leased and demised to Leonard Helwagen permission to occupy and use for private docklanding purposes, the inner slope and waterfront of the southerly embankment of Indian Lake, that is included in the west twenty-five (25') feet of embankment lot No. 29, east of Lakeview, Ohio, Logan County.

Upon examination of the leases hereinabove referred to, both of which are for a stated term of fifteen years, I find that both of same have been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner and by the lessees therein named.

I further find, upon examination of the provisions of these leases and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which these leases are executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving these leases as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the leases and upon the
