Investigative Activity: Collection of Autopsy Evidence (Scene #4)

On August 9, 2023, as part of an ongoing investigation of an officer involved critical incident, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Gill retrieved evidence from the Franklin County Coroner's Office (FCCO).

At 1545 hours, CST Gill met with FCCO receptionist Sophia Vance and received a brown bag containing evidence from the autopsy of Austin Huntzinger. CST Gill returned to the Ohio BCI Office located in London, Ohio, where the evidence was secured in the BCI Crime Scene Unit temporary evidence locker at 1700 hours.

On August 10, 2023 at 0935 hours, all items were removed from the Crime Scene Unit temporary evidence locker, packaged, and labeled as the following:

At 1152 hours, CST Gill submitted item 7 to the BCI laboratory. Items 1-6 were placed in the BCI Temporary Evidence Locker #2 at 1210 hours to be submitted to the BCI major crimes evidence vault.
