DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain leases executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Flatrock Township, Henry County, Ohio, leasing and demising to the State for the purpose therein stated tracts of land in said township and county.

The leases here in question, designated with respect to the number of the lease, the owner of the property and the acreage of land covered by the respective leases, are as follows:

Each and all of these leases are for a term five (5) years and in each instance the property described is leased to the state for the sole purpose of a state game refuge.
