Narrative:

On November 5, 2024, Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel (Rammel) reviewed the body worn camera (BWC) footage from **Sector Control** of the Findlay Police Department (FPD) regarding the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that took place at 1105 Bernard Avenue, Findlay, Ohio, 45840 on October 28, 2024.

The BWC footage began at 18:36:15 on October 28, 2024, and the length of the footage is 28 minutes and 49 seconds.

The footage begins with **the second** in his vehicle driving. The audio for the footage begins at 18:36:46.

At 18:36:50, **Contacted** three individuals sitting at a picnic table in the park. advised the reason he was making contact, and multiple bottles of orange colored alcohol can be seen on the ground between a male and female.

At 18:37:08, the female pulls an orange vape pen from her sweatshirt pocket and sets it on the table at **command**. The female advised that the vape pen is "just nicotine".

At 18:37:37, all three individuals confirmed that they are juveniles, and all advised that they do not have licenses.

At 18:38:31, the first juvenile male identified himself as Kalvin Darapheth (Kalvin).

At 18:39:37, the juvenile female identified herself as Autumn Pickney (Pickney).

At 18:40:36, Officer Noah Burkholder (Burkholder) arrived on scene.

At 18:41:54, the third juvenile, still unidentified, informed **control** that he was currently on probation.

At 18:42:26, the third juvenile identified himself to Burkholder as Sam Milledge (Sam).

At 18:43:34, Kalvin attempted to contact his mother as **sector** took possession of all the alcoholic beverages before bringing them to his cruiser.

At 18:45:10, Kalvin was able to reach his mother as explained to her the reason for the phone call.

At 18:45:52, **Matrix** informed Kalvin and his mother that Kalvin was going to be arrested and brought to the Findlay Police Department. Kalvin's mother mentioned something about him having a warrant for his arrest before the phone call cut out.

At 18:46:30, Pickney inquired if she could be taken to the hospital instead of the police department because she needed "mental help" and that was "what's wrong with me (Pickney)". Explained that first he needed to address the alcohol issue before discussing the hospital.

At 18:47:12, Kalvin's mother called back and stated that the initial call had been disconnected. proceeded to inform Kalvin's mother about the details of the arrest and that she could pick Kalvin up from the Findlay Police Department in approximately 40 minutes.

At 18:48:16, during **Contraction** call with Kalvin's mother, Pickney can be seen on the BWC emptying her pockets onto the picnic table for Burkholder.

At 18:48:35, Kalvin is seen leaving every eyesight and heard running away behind immediately begins a foot pursuit with handcuffs visible in his hand.

At 18:48:38, two (2) shots are fired as Kalvin is running away. A spark is seen on BWC indicating that one of the shots came from right behind Kalvin and appeared to strike the ground.

SA Ryan Emahiser (Emahiser) utilized an "Amped Replay" device to slow down the BWC footage and enhance the screen shots to clear up the BWC images as much as possible. Two screen shots were taken of the footage at the time that Kalvin fired two (2) shots while attempting to run from **Example**.

In the first image Kalvin's arm can be seen extended backwards when the first shot occurred.

In the second image Kalvin's arm can be seen behind him extended towards the ground. Sparks can be seen from a ricochet caused by Kalvin's second shot striking the ground behind him as he continued to run from **second**.

At 18:48:42, returned fire as Kalvin continued to run away.

Between 18:48:42 and 18:48:46, fired eight (8) rounds total at Kalvin as Kalvin continued to run away from Kalvin can be seen running into a tree line across the railroad tracks from

At 18:48:51, two (2) additional shots can be heard in the distance. weapon can be seen held down to his side as he is running, indicating that it was very unlikely that it was firing the final two rounds.

At 18:48:56, don't know where he went".

At 18:48:58, Kalvin can be seen in the distance on the ground as gave multiple commands for Kalvin to "stay the fuck down".

At 18:49:14, both and Burkholder began to give multiple commands to Kalvin to "throw the gun out" as Kalvin is seen lying on the ground on his left side. Moans can be heard coming from Kalvin.

Commands are repeated from and Burkholder until 18:49:31 when Burkholder can be heard contacting dispatch and informing them that they have a "suspect who had been shot".

At 18:49:35, sirens can be heard in the distance getting louder as time proceeds.

and Burkholder continued to walk slowly towards Kalvin with their guns drawn as Kalvin can be heard moaning and crying.

At 18:49:53, **Mathematical** informed dispatch that Kalvin was bleeding profusely and that medics were needed.

At 18:50:11, provided clear directions to dispatch as to the easiest route to where Kalvin was.

At 18:50:27, **EXAMPLE** informed dispatch that Kalvin had at least one gunshot wound and possibly more due to a visible head injury.

At 18:50:36, Burkholder advised that he saw that the gun was not in Kalvin's possession and approached Kalvin on the ground.

At 18:51:00, began to put on gloves and started to attend to Kalvin's wounds.

At 18:51:40, **The second of the second of th**

At 18:52:13, another cruiser arrived at **Control** and Kalvin.

At 18:53:25, an unidentified Findlay Police Officer applied a chest seal to the wound on Kalvin's back on the left side before all officers assist with moving Kalvin onto his back.

At 18:54:13, a second chest seal is used on a wound in Kalvin's upper right chest area. Kalvin can be heard moaning and gasping as he is breathing.

At 18:54:33, the unidentified officer advised that the head wound was gushing blood and directed the other officers to check Kalvin's legs for additional injuries. Kalvin's pants are removed for additional medical evaluations. **Security** was asked how many shots were fired. **Security** and Burkholder say that they do not know.

At 18:55:34, as other individuals attended Kalvin, **Example** and Burkholder located a firearm in the leaves and cleared the chamber to make the gun safe. The firearm was secured and taken into custody.

At 18:56:47, **Example and Burkholder are informed that the two other juveniles did not** leave the scene and were still at the picnic table.

At 18:57:20, **Contract of** confirmed that he was not hit by any fired shots but mentioned that Kalvin fired "a couple of shots".

At 18:58:22, Kalvin is removed from the scene by medics and placed on a gurney. Additional conversations can be heard in the background that the scene needs to be "taped".

At 18:59:00, assisted with putting crime scene tape around the area where Kalvin was lying on the ground. directed the other officers to the area where the shots took place.

At 19:01:00, while securing the scene **commented** that he "hope(d) the other kids were all right".

At 19:02:05, and is told not to do anything else by a superior officer. The same officer orders another Findlay Officer to take to the Findlay Police Department is instructed not to talk to anyone about the shooting.

At 19:03:43, returned to his cruiser to set up a perimeter with it.

At 19:05:04, **Example** is seen turning off his BWC, and the footage ended. No additional BWC related to **Example** was taken.

ADDITIONAL FACTORS FOR EVALUATING THE VIDEO RECORDINGS

There are numerous other factors that need to be considered when reviewing and evaluating the videos and audio recordings of this incident. Those factors are:

A. Video recording devices record within the video and sound capabilities available, and they record objectively. Video recordings lack the history, perspective, and interest of the people involved. The positions, angles, obstacles, lighting, and distance from the incident are also factors that need serious consideration.

B. Video recording devices also record more information about a particular scene or incident than the person(s) involved in the incident can process during the critical incident. Video recording devices rarely record an event from the same perspective of the officer. It captures the action but not the perception, decision making, focus, or intent of the officer. Video recordings often miss tactile cues or other actions of a subject.

C. The speed of the incident is remarkable. The speed and complexity of rapidly evolving situation(s) that occur during use of force encounters are difficult concepts to comprehend by only watching the video.
