DEAR SIR:—You have submitted to me for approval a contract (five copies) between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Welfare, and the Babcock & Wilcox Company, of Pittsburgh, Pa. This contract is for two water tube boilers for the Toledo State Hospital of the Department of Public Welfare, as covered by the proposal of the party of the first part which proposal is made a part of this contract, and calls for an expenditure of fourteen thousand, two hundred and eighty (\$14,280.00) dollars.

Accompanying said contract is a bond to insure faithful performance, executed by the Royal Indemnity Company.
